Pray

Sing & Listen

Talk

- How do we know Joseph really loved his brothers?
- Would Joseph have really loved his brothers if he said he did but did not provide for them?

- Where do we learn how to truly love one another?

Teach

- Read **1 John 3:16**
- Who laid down His life for us? **Jesus**.
- Why did he lay down His life for us? **To save us from our sins**.
- How do we receive this gift of salvation? **Repent and believe in Jesus**.

Pray and Sing

- Pray for God to help you love others like Jesus.
- More Prayer ideas: Pray for one another, pray the Lord's prayer, pray for our church family, pray for people to stay safe in the storm, pray for lost people to know Jesus, pray for a chance to share Jesus with your neighbors, pray for missionaries, and more.
