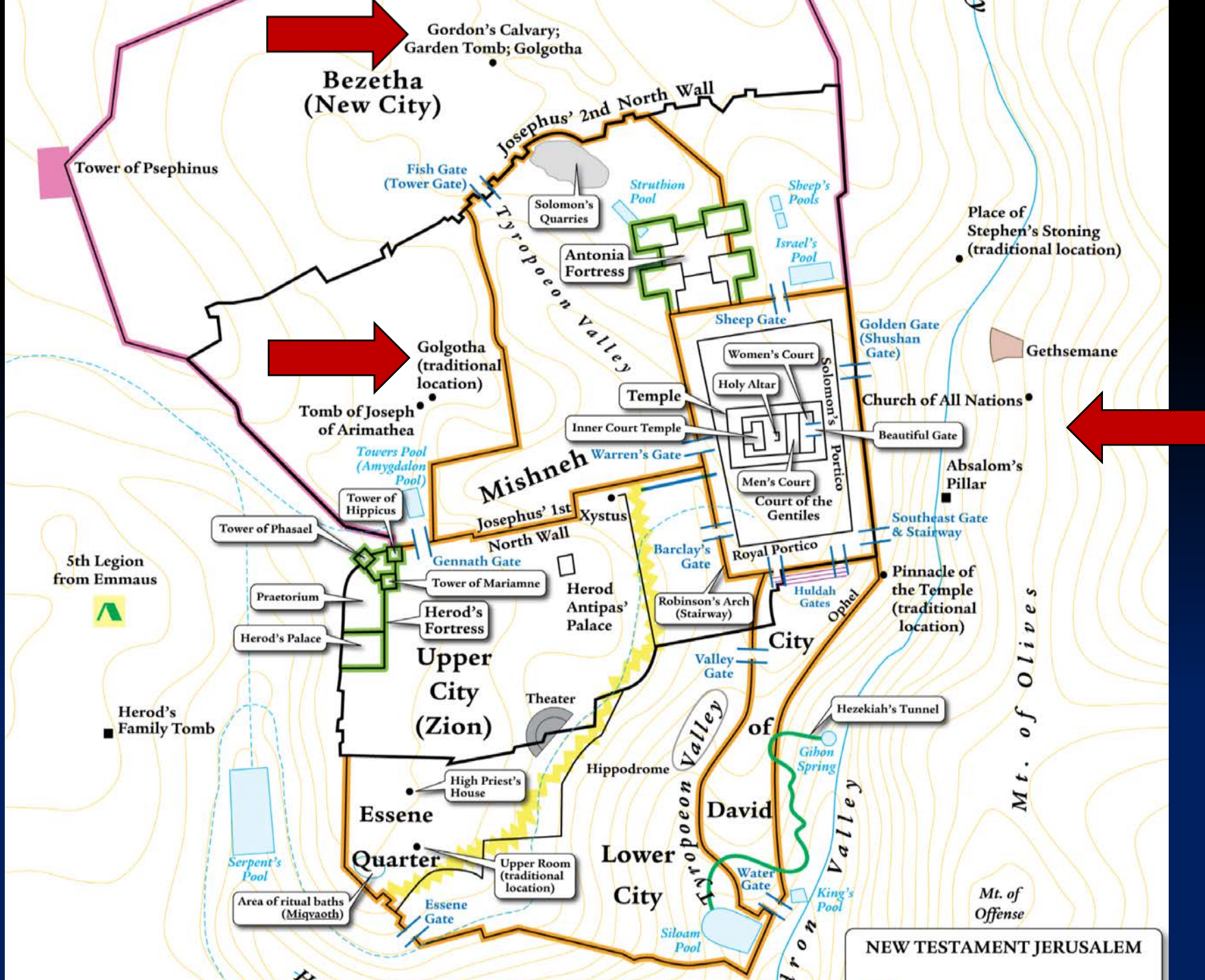
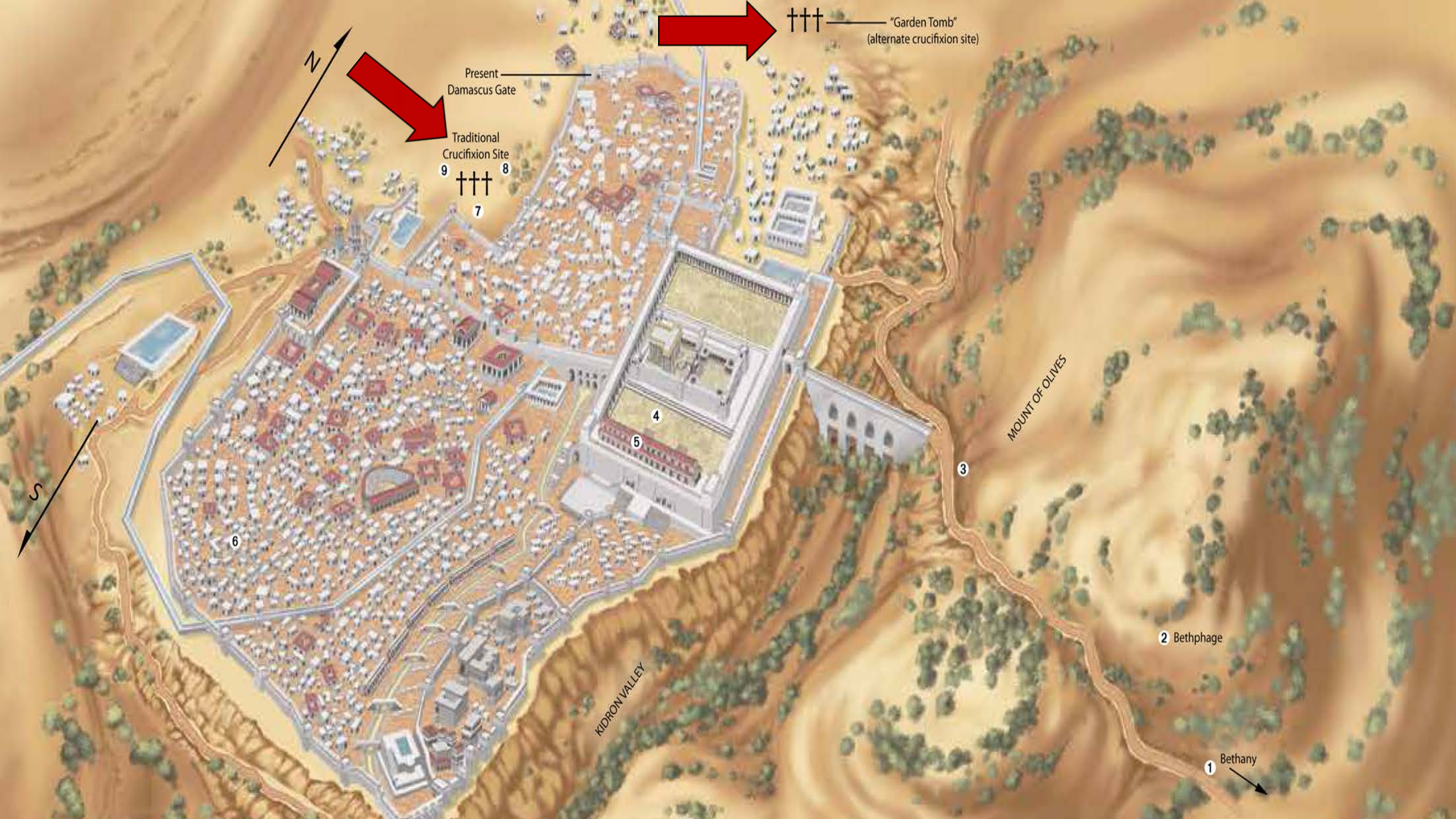

## **2 Samuel 15:30**

**This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was nigh to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, and Greek, and Latin.**

# **John 19:42**

**There laid they Jesus  
therefore because of the  
Jews' preparation day; for  
the sepluchre was nigh at  
hand.**

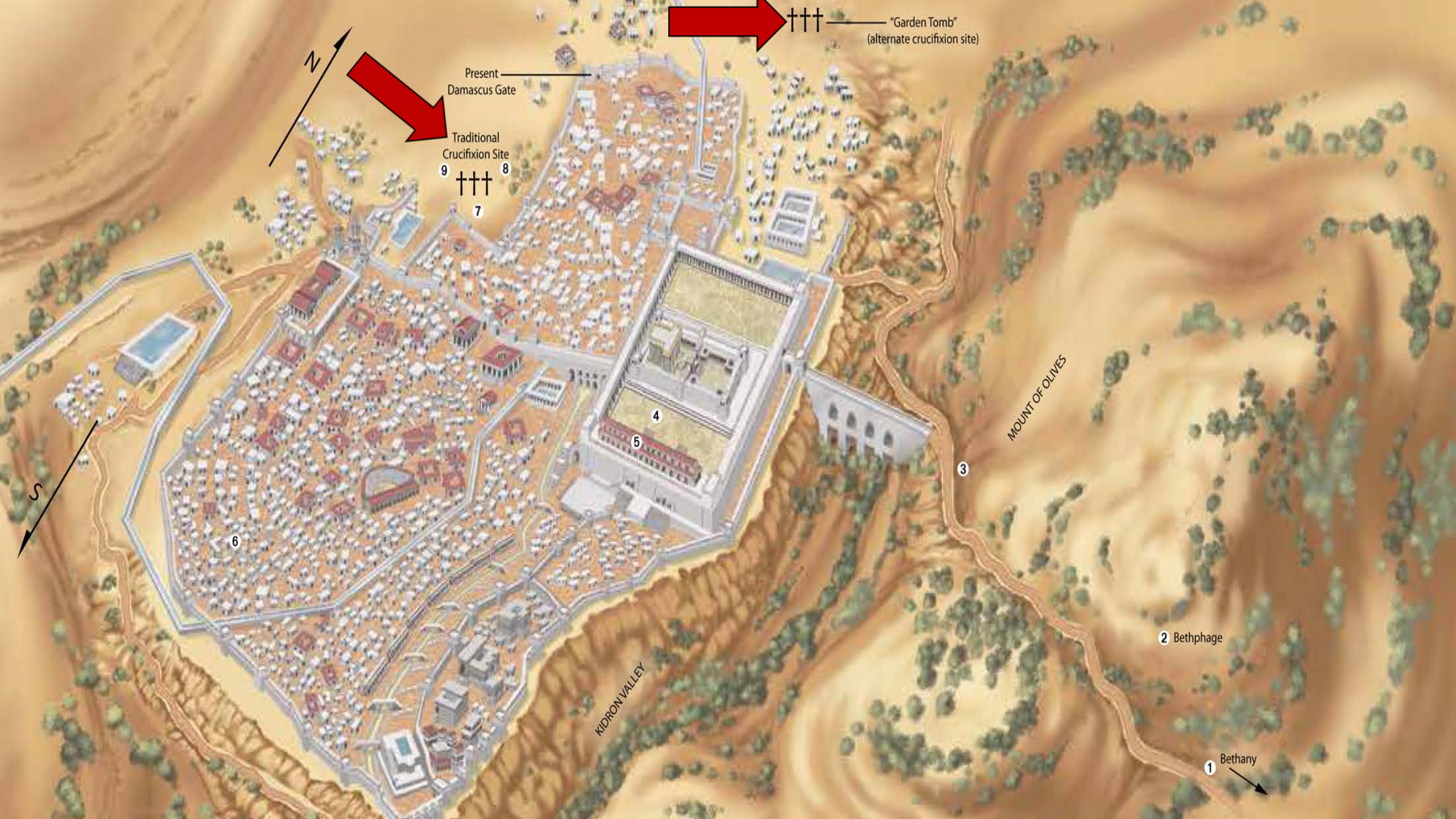

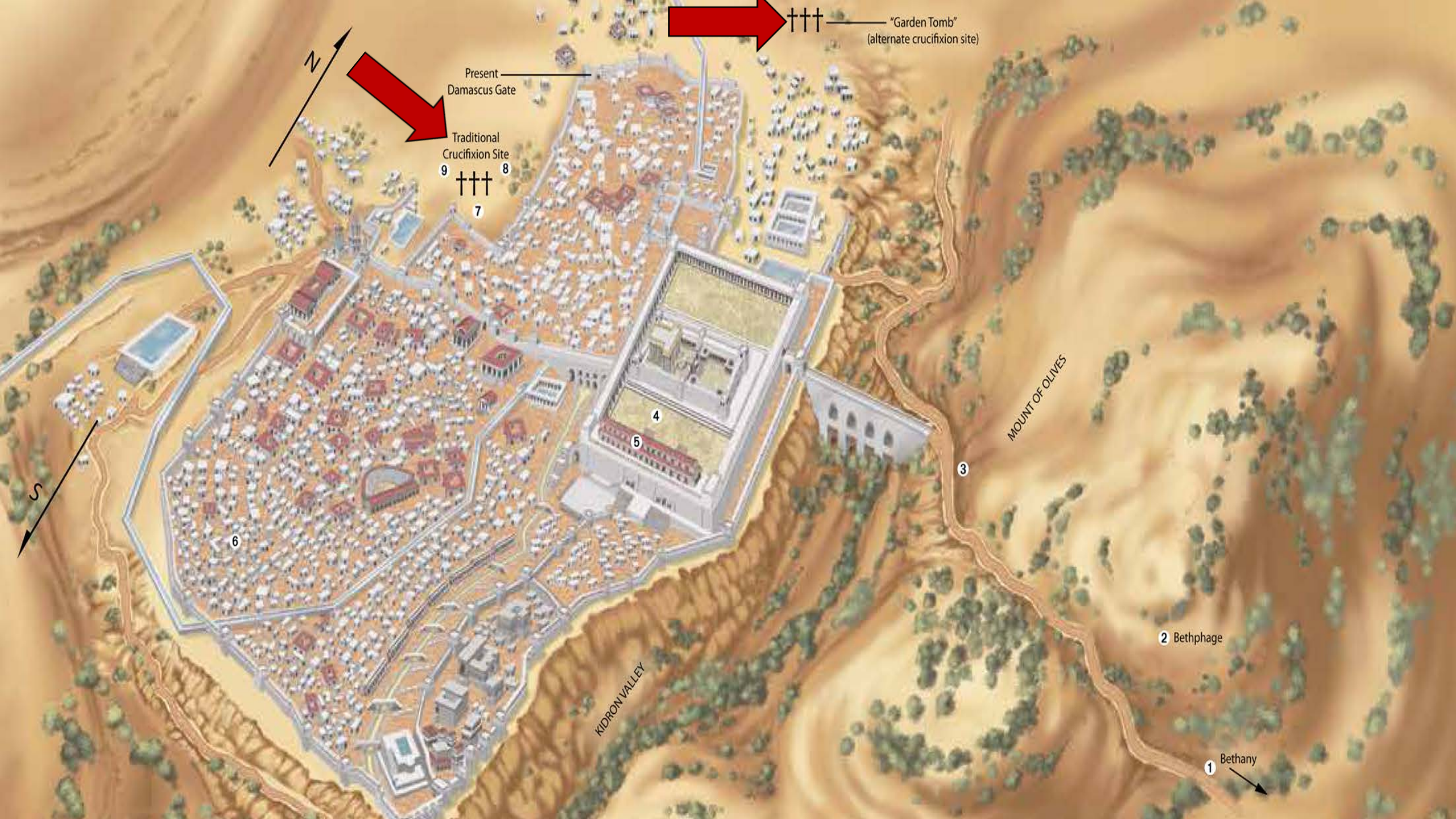
# Mark 15:21

# **Matthew 27:51**

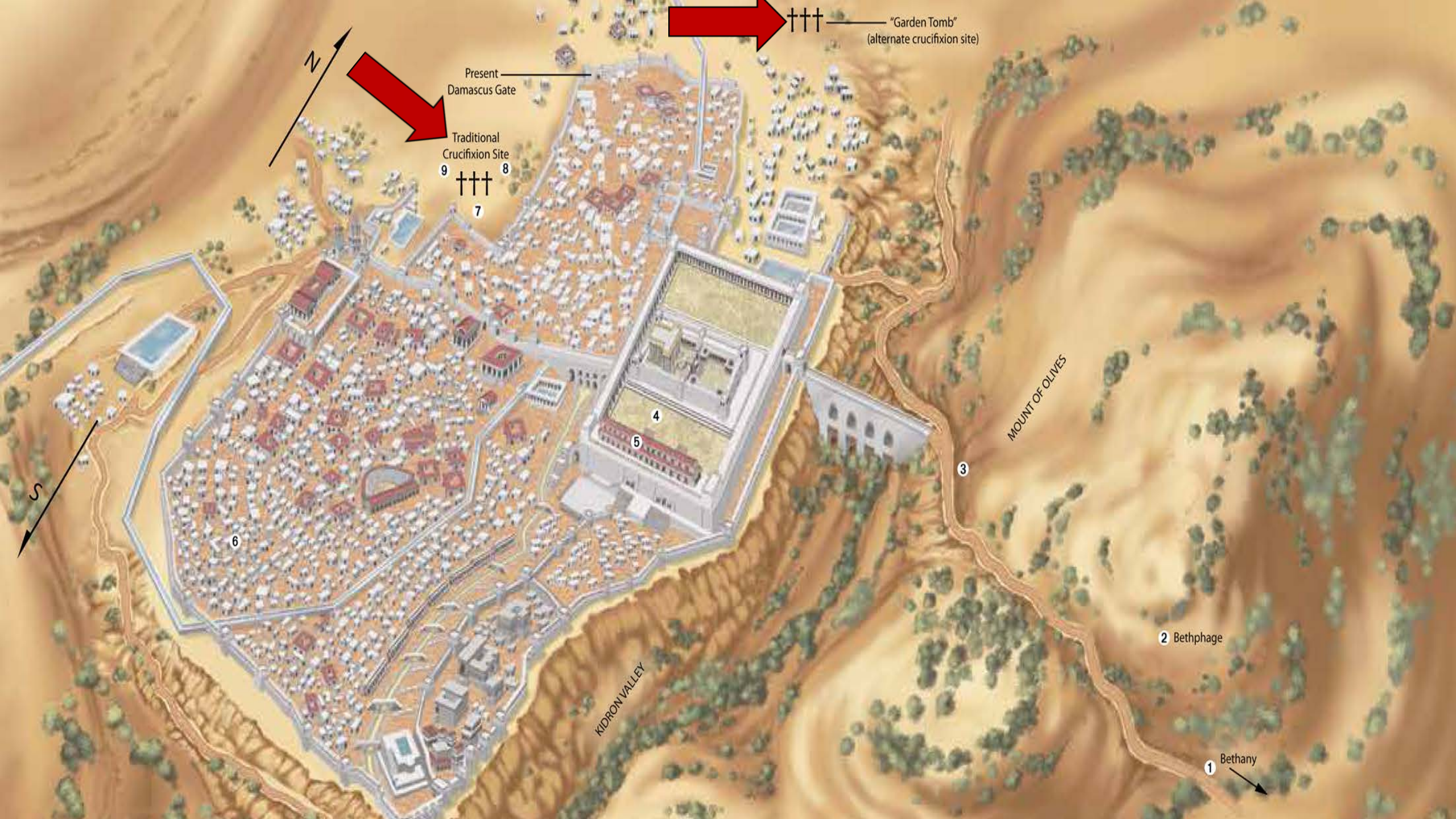
**And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;**

away from the sepulchre.**

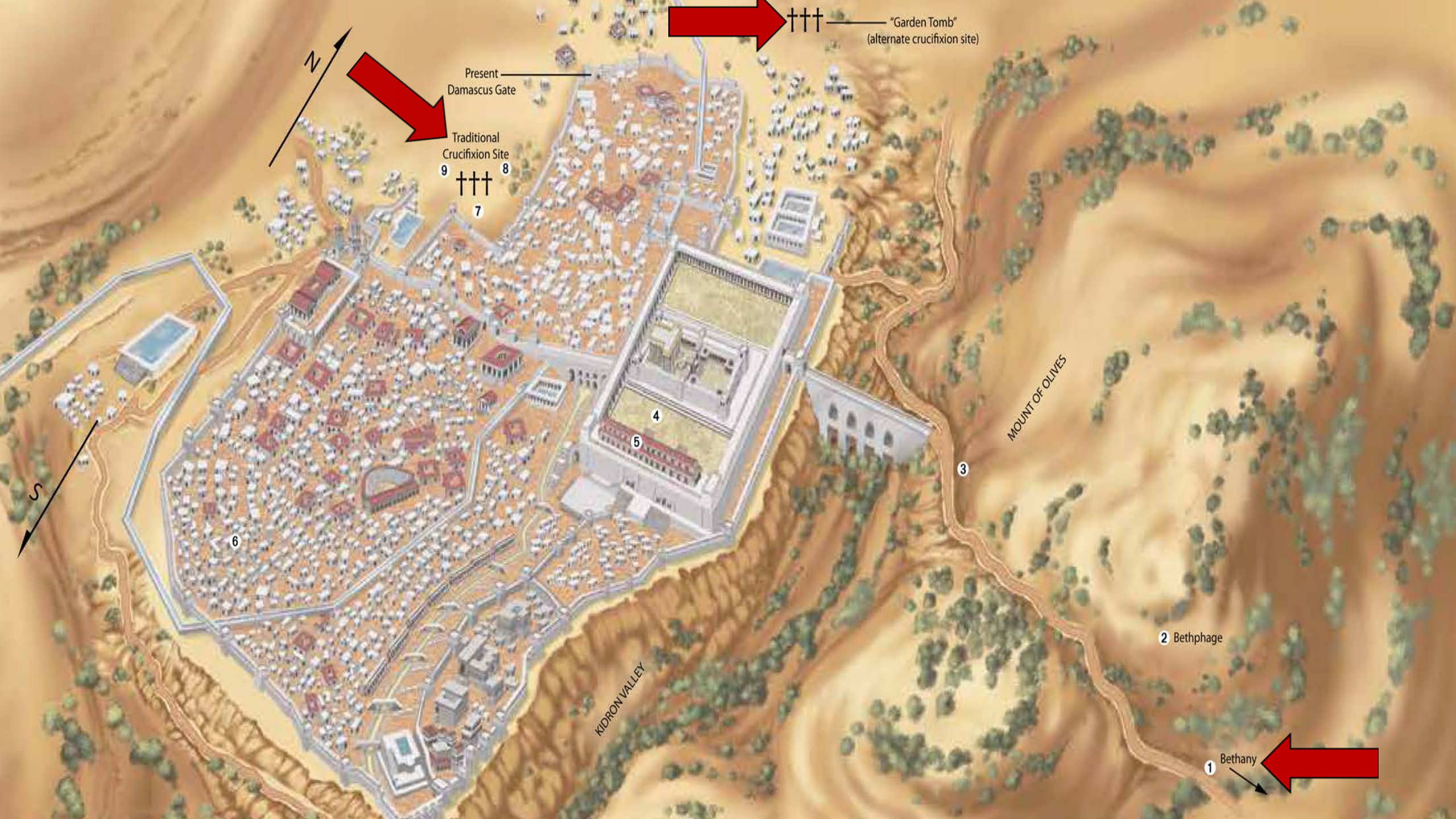


# **John 20:2**

Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

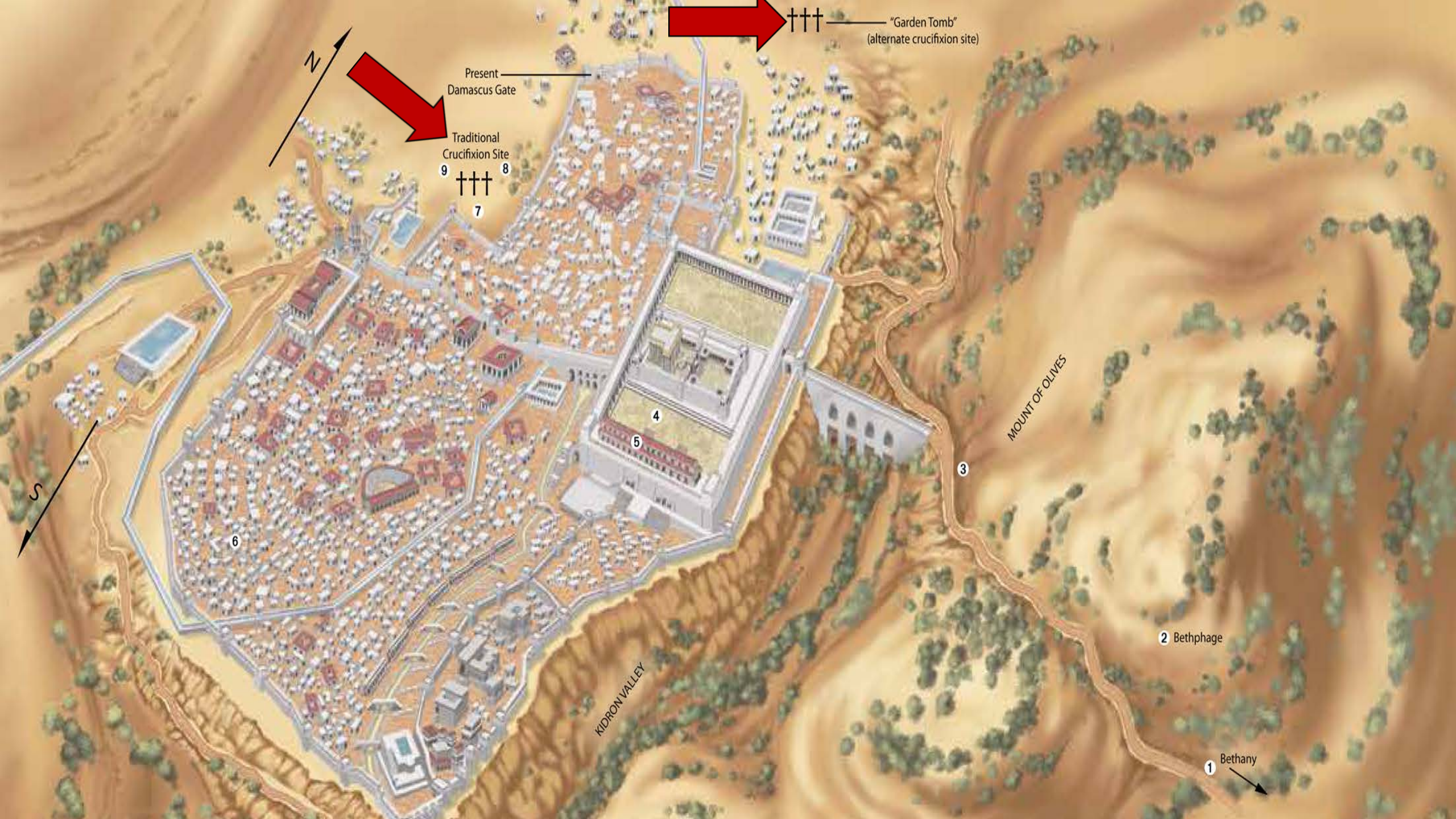
# Hebrews 13:13

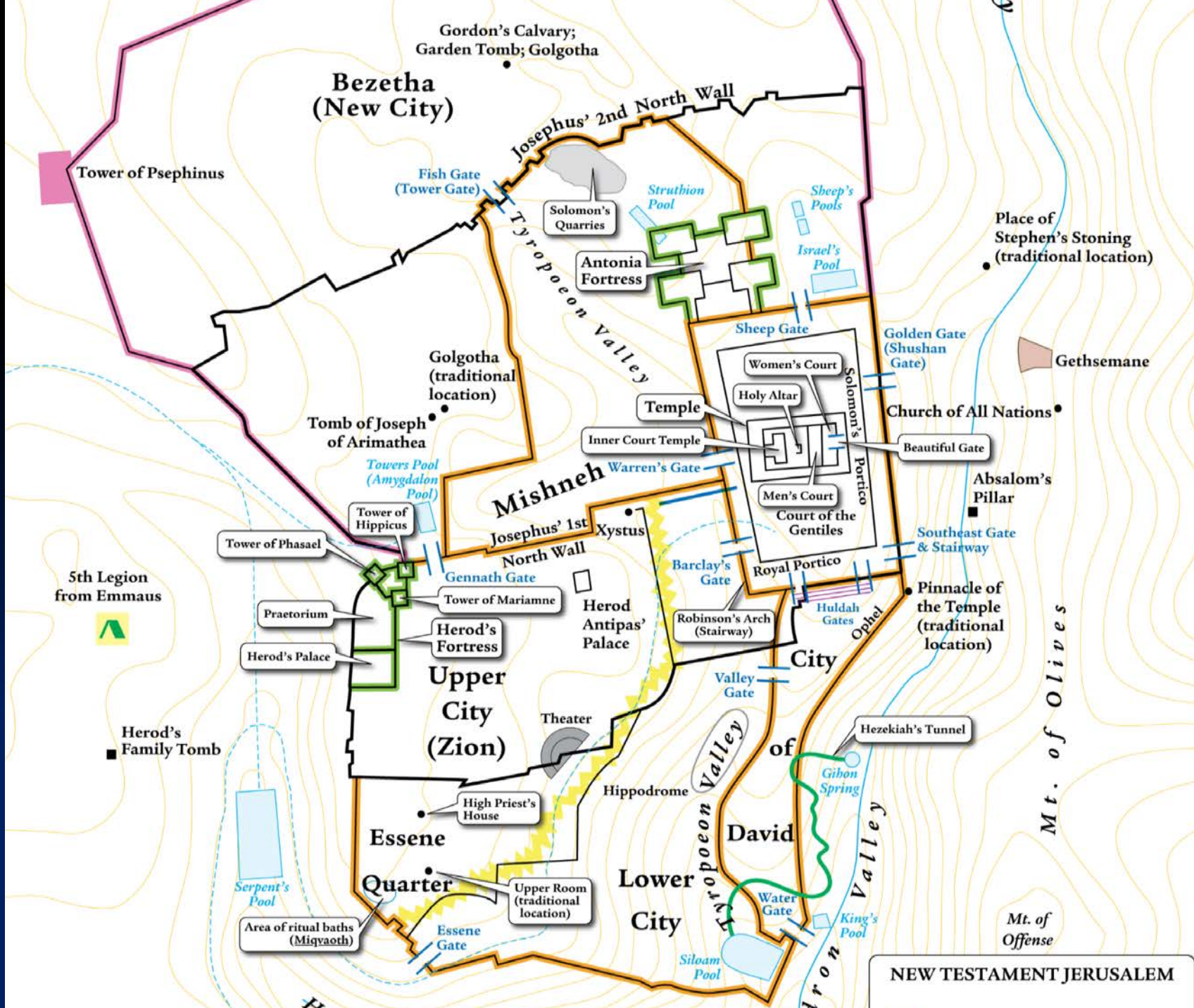
