Joseph of Arimathaea, an honorable counselor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus.

This man went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus.

53 And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.

preparation, and the
sabbath drew on.

John 19:31

The Jews therefore, because it was the **preparation**, that the bodies should not remain upon the cross on the **sabbath day**, (for that **sabbath day was an high day**,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away.

Exodus 12:15

Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the **first day** ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the **seventh day**, that soul shall be cut off from Israel.

Exodus 12:16

And in the **first day** there shall be an holy convocation, and in the **seventh day** there shall be an holy convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done of you.
