John 10:1-10

*I AM the Bread of Life*

**“Then Jesus declared, ‘I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will not be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.’ John 6:35**

*I AM the Light of the World*

**“When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but have the light of life.” John 8:12**

*I AM the Gate*

**7 Therefore Jesus said again, “Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. 9 I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. John 10:7, 9**

3 Takeaways from John 10:1-10
