Four "Plays" for Words of Worship

Play 3

Worship Words **DIRECT** Your Life



Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT) "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."



Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT) "Trust in the Lord with all your heart;

"Trust" in Hebrew is "batach" to lean so fully that if the object moves, you fall





Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT) ...he will show you (carries) which path to take."

"Path" in Hebrew is "orach" — a well-trodden road.

- When you worship / trust God directs / <u>carries</u> you onto His paths of blessing.





Psalm 37:5 (NLT)

"Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust him, and he will help you."

The Hebrew word for "commit" means to "roll it onto."







Proverbs 16:9 (NLT) "We can make our plans, but the Lord <u>determines our steps</u>."

In Hebrew, "determines our steps "means: to "make smooth, straight."

When you lean on God He removes obstacles you couldn't see.











BIG IDEA

Sometimes God's direction doesn't lead us to safety it leads us to significance.





Proverbs 16:9 (NLT) "We can make our plans, but the Lord <u>determines our steps</u>."

In Hebrew, "determines our steps "means: to "make smooth, straight."

When you lean on God He removes obstacles you couldn't see.







Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)

"Don't be afraid, for I am with you.
Don't be discouraged, for I am your God.
I will strengthen you and help you.
I will hold you up with my victorious right hand."





Play 4

Worship Words Deliver Breakthrough





Acts 16:25–26 (NLT)

"Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening. Suddenly, there was a massive earthquake, and the prison was shaken to its foundations. All the doors immediately flew open, and the chains of every prisoner fell off!"







BIG IDEA

Worship isn't a response to breakthrough... worship is the key that brings breakthrough.







Daniel 3:17-18 (NLT)

"If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God whom we serve is able to save us. He will rescue us from your power, Your Majesty. But even if he doesn't, we want to make it clear to you... that we will never serve your gods or worship the gold statue you have set up."





Daniel 3:17-18 (NLT)

"Look! I see four men, unbound, walking around in the fire unharmed! And the fourth looks like a god!"



BIG IDEA

When you worship boldly in the fire - Jesus shows up in the flames.





Mindset Shift Fire doesn't destroy worshipers ... it refines them.



Jonah 2:9-10 (NLT)

From the belly of the fish Jonah declared, "I will offer sacrifices to you with songs of praise..." and the Lord commanded the fish to release him.
