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Play 3

Worship Words **DIRECT** Your Life



Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT)

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart;
do not depend on your own understanding.
Seek his will in all you do,
and he will show you which path to take.”



Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT)

Trust in the Lord with all your heart;

“Trust” in Hebrew is “batach”
to lean so fully that if the object moves, you fall



Proverbs 3:5–6 (NLT)

...he will show you (carries)
which path to take.”

“Path” in Hebrew is “orach” — a well-trodden road.

- When you worship / trust God directs / carries you
onto His paths of blessing.



Psalm 37:5 (NLT)

Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust him, and he will help you.”

The Hebrew word for “commit”
means to “roll it onto.”





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Proverbs 16:9 (NLT)

“We can make our plans,
but the Lord **determines our steps.**”

In Hebrew, “determines our steps” means:
to “make smooth, straight.”

When you lean on God
He removes obstacles you couldn't see.



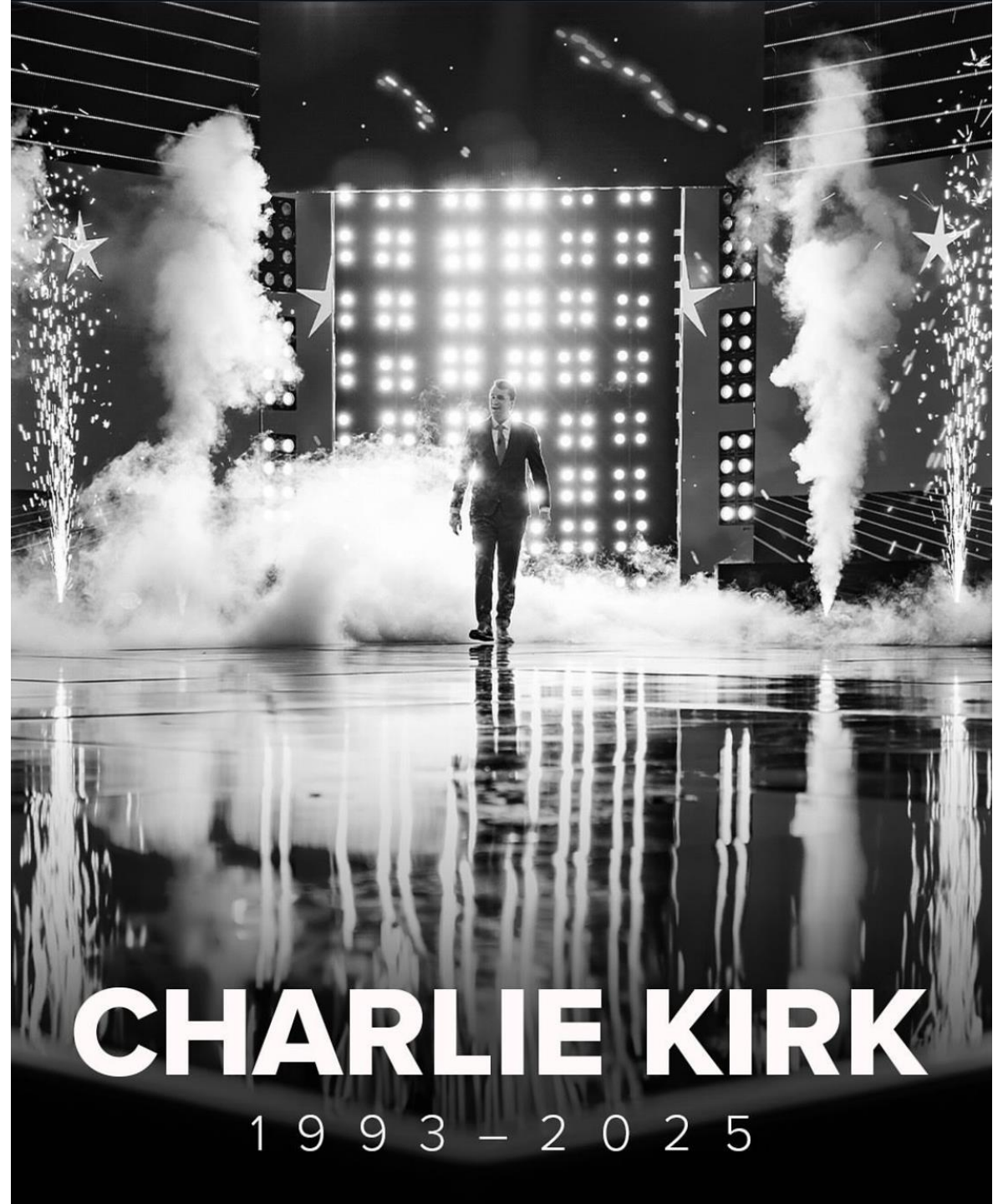

“Don’t be afraid, for I am with you.
Don’t be discouraged, for I am your God.
I will strengthen you and help you.

I will hold you up with my victorious right hand.”

Worship Words Deliver Breakthrough



Acts 16:25–26 (NLT)

“Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening. Suddenly, there was a massive earthquake, and the prison was shaken to its foundations. All the doors immediately flew open, and **the chains of every prisoner fell off!**”

breakthrough...
worship is the key that brings
breakthrough.
