James 4:6,10 - 6 "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble..."10 Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honor.





Humility required two mental activities

- 1. You see the weaknesses in you You repent / grieve sin
- 2. You see the righteousness in God You worship / exalt Him







Jeremiah 32:6-9,11 - 6 And Jeremiah said, "The word of the Lord came to me, saying, 7 'Behold, Hanamel...will come to you, saying, "Buy my field which is in Anathoth, for the right of redemption is yours to buy it." 8 Then Hanamel my uncle's son came to me in the court of the prison according to the word of the Lord, and said to me, 'Please buy my field... for the right of inheritance is yours, and the redemption yours; buy it for yourself.' Then I knew that this was the word of the Lord. 9 So I bought the field from Hanamel...11 So I took the purchase deed, both that which was sealed according to the law and custom, and that which was open (deed)...















Genesis 1:26 - Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over...





Luke 4:5-6 - 5 Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6 And the devil said to Him, "All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me...







Matthew 16:19 - And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."





Luke 11:22-24 - 22 Jesus said to them, "Have faith in God. 23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. 24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.







Colossians 2:15 - "He (Jesus) disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him."





Revelation 5:9-10 - "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, 10 And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth."







Exodus 32:9-11, 9 And the Lord said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and indeed it is a stiff-necked people! 10 Now therefore, let Me alone, that My wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them. And I will make of you a great nation."11 Then Moses pleaded with the Lord his God, and said...12 Turn from Your fierce wrath, and relent from this harm to Your people.14 So the Lord relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people.





Jonah 4:2 - So he prayed to the Lord, and said, "Ah, Lord, was not this what I said when I was still in my country? Therefore I fled previously to Tarshish; for I know that You are a gracious and merciful God, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, One who relents from doing harm.







1 Timothy 2:1-4 - 1 I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. 2 Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity. 3 This is good and pleases God our Savior, 4 who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.
