Sermon Information:

Gathering

Hebrews 10:23-25; Colossians 3:12-17

We gather to encourage and exhort one another in faithful living.

We gather to corporately worship God as the people of God.

- Corporate worship expresses our connection to God.
- Corporate worship demonstrates our imitation of God.
- Corporate worship is our response to God.

Discussion Questions:

1. Has there been times that the Christian life has felt like a religious checklist to you? What have you done to fight against that mindset? Explain what it means for the activities of the church and Christian life to be means of grace.
2. Read Hebrews 3:12-15. What does this passage teach us about the importance of exhorting and encouraging one another? How have you experienced helpful exhortation from the church in the past? How can you offer it to others today?
3. Read Colossians 3:12-17. What are the things that this passage calls us to do for the others in our Christian community? Are we doing these things as we gather together? How can we improve in doing these things?
4. “More people worshipping more is better than fewer people worshipping better.” Do you agree with this statement? How should this truth affect the way we conduct our worship services?
5. If worship is a response to God, then how should we prepare our minds and our hearts before coming to corporate worship on Sundays?
