Sermon Information:

A Greater Glory Haggai 2:1-9

Wrong perspectives can hinder God's people from doing His work.

We should look <u>back</u> and be encouraged by God's <u>faithfulness</u>.

We should look forward and be encouraged by God's promises.

Discussion Questions:

- **4.** Can you think of some promises from God that encourage you? After you try to think of some on your own, look up these: Psalm 94:14, Isaiah 41:10, Matthew 6:33, Romans 8:38-39, 2 Corinthians 9:8, Philippians 4:19, and James 4:6-8.
- **5.** Discuss how you can pay attention to your perspective this week and how you can correct it to a godly perspective.
