Sermon Information:

Strategic Generosity Luke 16:1-13

We seek to be both generous and strategic in the sharing of our resources, talents, and gifts to achieve the greatest impact.

Connection:

- We are <u>stewards</u>, not owners.
- We must make decisions about the <u>future</u>.

Contrast:

- We operate according to the economy of the Kingdom, not the world.
- We should invest in <u>eternity</u>, not the temporary.

Application:

- Which <u>lord</u> will we serve?
- Will we be <u>faithful</u> with what we have been given?
- Will we give generously towards eternal investments?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What do you find confusing about the parable that Jesus tells in Luke 16:1-9? What would you say is the main point of the parable?
- 2. In which areas of life do you tend to see yourself as an owner rather than a steward (finances, time, home, etc.)? How can you work to adjust that perspective?
- 3. How is the economy of the Kingdom different from the economy of the world? How do you need to adjust your thinking and living to be according to the Kingdom?
- 4. Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19. What do these verses teach us about how we should steward the things God has given us? What do these verses teach us making eternal investments?
- 5. In what ways have you seen FirstSF practice strategic generosity? How can we continue to make this a core value for each of our members and our church as a whole?
