

Sermon Discussion Questions
For the Week of March May 29, 2022

Sermon Information:

The Lord's Supper
Luke 22:14-20

As Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper, he pointed to the...

- Past: He showed that he would accomplish a greater passover.
- Present: He stated that he would be the substitutionary sacrifice.
- Future: He promised that we would share a great feast in the eternal kingdom.

Discussion Questions:

1. Do you think it is significant that God has called His people to gather around the table to celebrate and anticipate for thousands of years? How should this impact the way we observe the Lord's Supper? How should this impact the way we treat meals away from church?
2. Reflect on Jesus' repeated words "for you" in verses 19 and 20. Why is it important to remember that Jesus' sacrifice served as a substitute on our behalf? How should this affect the way we think about our sins?
3. Read Revelation 19:6-9. Discuss the fact that this passage describes God as the Almighty who reigns and as the bridegroom of the Church. Why is it important to keep both of these images in mind as we consider our relationship with God?
4. How can the hope of a great feast in the eternal kingdom give us peace in the midst of a broken world? How should the hope compel us to practice righteousness, justice, and hospitality in the midst of a broken world?
5. What would you say is your main takeaway from this series? How can you keep a focus on practicing hospitality even though this series has ended?
