Sermon Discussion Questions

Sermon Information:

Grumbling over Grace Matthew 20:1-16

We must submit to God's <u>sovereignty</u>. We can trust God's <u>integrity</u>. We should rejoice because of God's <u>generosity</u>.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Can you relate to the workers who grumbled in this story? Can you think of a time when you felt like you weren't treated fairly? How did you respond?
- 2. The root of legalism is the belief that the good things we do help us to earn or keep God's love and blessings. How do you see this belief show up in your life?
- 3. Part of not grumbling over grace is learning to submit to God's sovereignty. Why is it often hard to submit to God's sovereignty? How can we daily remind ourselves that God is over all things and that all belongs to Him?
- 4. God doesn't always give us the same experiences as other believers, but He does give us exactly what He has promised us. What are some specific promises God has given us (find them in Scripture)?
- 5. During this week of Thanksgiving, what is one thing that you can do to rejoice over God's generosity?
