**Sermon Information:**

Giving  
2 Corinthians 9:6-15

The gospel compels us to radical generosity.

- We give out of thankfulness for all we have received from God.
- We give so that others might give thanks to God.

**Discussion Questions:**

1. When it comes to giving, what do you think is hardest for you to give (money, time, gifts/abilities, etc.)? What is easiest? Why do you think that is?
2. Pastor Ben spoke about radical generosity and measured generosity. Which do you think describes your approach to giving? Discuss the balance of needing to spend/save and the call to give to others. Have you seen examples of radical generosity?
3. Read Psalm 130. What reasons does this psalm offer for us to give thanks to God? How can you personalize this psalm in your life? This week, meditate on this psalm and focus on being thankful to God.
4. Read 1 Corinthians 16:1-4 and 2 Corinthians 8:12-15. What practical advice does Paul offer about giving/generosity in these passages? How will you follow this advice and seek to be generous this week?
5. If it is the gospel that compels us to radical generosity, how can we practically focus on the gospel and remind ourselves of the gospel each day? How can we help each other in this endeavor?
