Sermon Information:

Truly This Is the Son of God
Matthew 14:13-36

Jesus has all you need, so trust him with your resources.

Jesus is sovereign over all, so trust him in every season.

Jesus is worthy of your worship, so come to him and be healed.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Matthew 14:13-14. How do you tend to react when people interrupt your time alone? How did Jesus react? What practical steps can we take to help us have the reaction of Jesus?
2. Read Matthew 14:15-16. Is there a need that seems insurmountable that God is calling us as His people to meet? In what ways can we entrust with Him with our resources so that He can work in and through us?
3. How does the story in Matthew 14:22-33 compare with the story in Matthew 8:23-27? What do the stories teach us about Jesus? How can we learn from the disciples?
4. Explain the following statement: The most important thing is not the measure of our faith, but the object of our faith. How do we see this statement depicted in the story of Peter walking on water? How does this story give us hope even in the midst of doubt?
5. Worship is not bringing God what He needs but recognizing that He is all that we need. What people/things are you most tempted to worship other than God? How can you fight the temptation to worship these idols?
