Discussion Questions:

2. Why is it significant that the gospel is the foundation of Christian community? Read Ephesians 4:1-6. What does the passage teach about the foundation of Christian community?
3. How have you been blessed by the active love of a Christian community? Are there ways that you could be showing love to others in our church community that you have been neglecting?
4. Read Acts 2:47. What would it look like for a Christian community in San Francisco to have favor with all people? Why is it important that Luke states that the Lord added to their number those who were being saved?
5. In what ways can FirstSF, and you personally, continue to make community a core value and high priority in our church?
