Discussion Questions:

1. Do you agree that materialism is the norm in our culture? If so, how should that affect how we think about biblical teachings about money and the love of money?
2. Read 1 Timothy 6:6-10. How have you seen the love of money been a root of all kinds of evil? How have you seen that in the world? How have you seen it in your own life?
3. When you look at your life, where might you be guilty of hoarding your wealth/possessions? Where are you guilty of self-indulgence? What changes will you make to your spending/saving in light of this?
4. Read Matthew 6:19-24. What does Jesus mean by treasures in heaven? What can you do this week to help you keep an eternal perspective, especially when it comes to money and possessions?
5. How could you share the truths of this passage with someone who isn't a believer? How can you use this passage to share the gospel this week?
