Intro: Relief video – South Louisiana, Texas, Venezuela . When we fail to see the majesty and greatness of God we lose sight of his power, judgement, justice, righteousness, holiness, goodness, faithfulness. We lose sight that he is all seeing, all knowing, all loving, all powerful, all mighty. He is sovereign, savior, redeemer, ruler, king of kings and lord of lords. This is our Great God, Jehovah, who's name was held so sacred that it was only spoken out loud once a year by the high priest. The greatness of his love and grace will never be appreciated or honored appropriately if we don't see the majesty of his name and the glory of his presence and greatness.

I. See His Glory: Moses

II. See His Glory: Enemies

- a. His glory is seen departing his people because they did not keep his covenant .
- b. 1 Samuel 4 - Israel defeated and the ark is captured. The death of Eli and his sons. Phinehas' wife gives birth and names him Ichabod which means no glory or glory departed.
- c. 1 Samuel 5:6 The Lord's hand was heavy upon the people The word for heavy in the Hebrew is the word for glory. The result was affliction and death.

III. See His Glory: Jesus

- a. John 1:14 We have seen his glory
- b. John 17:1-5 Jesus' prayer for God's glory.
- c. The God of the O.T. is the God of the N.T. He hasn't changed. There is no contradiction of his character but completion of his purpose. To save us by his son. To redeem us by his blood. To proclaim his glory by his cross and through his people.
