I. Open my eyes to see Jesus

- a. His message
- b. His direction
- c. His instruction

II. Open my heart obey Jesus

- a. Ananias had to obey
- b. Saul – Arise and be baptized washing away your sins

III. Open my mouth to speak Jesus

- a. In spite of opposition
- b. In spite of persecution
- c. To everyone from kings to peasants.

Conclusion: Acts 26: 17I am sending you to them to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.
