# Dangerous Prayers Dangerous Prayer # 4: <u>SEND ME</u>

### 1. Jonah – I'm your guy. But, I'm NOT GOING.

"...Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before Me'. But Jonah ran away from the Lord..." Jonah 1:1-3 (NIV)

### 2. Moses – I'm your guy. Send <u>SOMEONE ELSE</u>.

"So now go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring My people the Israelites out of Egypt.' But Moses said to God, Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?'" Exodus 3:10-11 (NIV)

### 3. Isaiah – I'm your guy. Send <u>ME</u>.

"Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, 'Whom shall I send? And who will go for Us?' And I said, 'Here am I. Send me!'" Isaiah 6:8 (NIV)

### Saying "Yes" to God's Purposes

### 1. <u>SEEK</u> Him with your whole heart.

"You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart." Jeremiah 29:13 (NIV)

### 2. <u>CONFRONT</u> your fears and be encouraged.

"The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. **Do not be afraid**; do not be discouraged." Deuteronomy 31:8 (NIV)

### 3. DO what God has called you to do.

"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says." James 1:22 (NIV)
