- Authored by Paul (written by Tertius; but, dictated by Paul)
- Written to Christians in Rome, about 57 A.D.

II. Who Is Paul?

- 1. Race & Religion **JEWISH PHARISEE**
- "...he shouted, 'Brothers, I am a Pharisee, as were my ancestors! And I am on trial because my hope is in the resurrection of the dead!" Acts 23:6b (NLT)
- 2. Culturally **GREEK**
- "...for as I was walking along I saw your many shrines. And one of your altars had this inscription on it: 'To an Unknown God.' This God, whom you worship without knowing, is the one I'm telling you about."

 Acts 17:23 (NLT)
- 3. Politically **ROMAN CITIZEN**
- "But Paul replied, 'They have publicly beaten us without a trial and put us in prison—and we are Roman citizens. So now they want us to leave secretly? Certainly not! Let them come themselves to release us!" Acts 16:37 (NLT)
 - Paul leveraged his <u>S.H.A.P.E</u> (Class 301) to connect people to Jesus Christ.
 - S Spiritual Gifts
 - H Heart
 - A Abilities
 - P Personality
 - **E** Experience

 - 1) The Problem of Sin (Romans 1:18-3:30) ... The Bad News... It's **WORSE** than you think.
 - 2) The Gift of Salvation (Romans 3:21-5:21) ... The Good News... It's <u>BETTER</u> than you think.

- 3) How to Live as a Christian (Romans 6:1-8:39) ... Practical Application... It's <u>HARDER</u> than you think.
- 4) God's Plan (Romans 9:1-11:36) ...
 A Look Behind the Curtain... It's **BIGGER** than you think.
- 5) What We're to Do Now (Rom 12:1-15:13) ...
 Job Assignment...It <u>TAKES MORE SACRIFICE</u> than you think.
- Conclusion (Romans 15:14-16:27)

- 1. "For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard." Romans 3:23 (NLT)
- 2. "But God showed His great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners." Romans 5:8 (NLT)
- 3. "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 6:23 (NLT)
- **4.** "If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9 (NLT)
- 5. "For Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved." Romans 10:13 (NLT)
