# Holy Moments: The Life of Joseph

### Matthew 1:18-24

#### I. What we know about Joseph:

- Matthew 1:18-25 Engaged, surprised, obedient, becomes a step-dad
- Matthew 2 Meets the Magi, more dreams, flees to Egypt, returns to Galilee
- Luke 2:41-52 Jesus with Mary and Joseph in Jerusalem
- Matthew 13:55 Craftsman and father to James, Joseph, Simon, Judas and several daughters
- Other references: Luke 3:23 and John 1:45

#### **II.** Joseph's holy defining moments:

"This is how Jesus the Messiah was born. His mother Mary, was engaged to be married to Joseph. But before the marriage took place, while she was still a virgin, she became pregnant through the power of the Holy Spirit." Matthew 1:18 (NLT)

"As he considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream. 'Joseph, son of David', the angel said, 'do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife... She will have a son, and you are to name Him Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.'" Matthew 1:20-21 (NLT)

"When Joseph woke up, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded and took Mary as his wife." Matthew 1:24 (NLT)

#### III. What do we learn from Joseph:

- 1. You don't have to <u>UNDERSTAND</u> completely to <u>OBEY</u> immediately! (Matthew 1:24)
  - **OBEDIENCE** is **<u>OUR</u> responsibility.**
  - The outcome is <u>GOD'S</u> responsibility.
  - Most of us don't need to KNOW more; we need to OBEY more.

#### 2. The enemy of obedience is **FEAR**. (Matthew 1:20)

• Don't WORRY when you face opposition for your obedience to God! WORRY when you don't!

- 3. Obedience leads to <u>HOLY MOMENTS</u> for you and for the Kingdom. (Matthew 1:20b)
  - God uses **ORDINARY** people to do EXTRAORDINARY things.
