Acts 9:32-43

I. A Day in the Lives of Dorcas and Peter

1. Dorcas

Always did kind things	Helped the poor	Did what she could (sewing) to help others, in Jesus' name
------------------------	-----------------	--

2. Peter's Transformation

Called from fishing (Matthew 4)	Let's build 3 monuments (Matthew 17)	Great sermon; 3,000 Professions of Faith decisions (Acts 2)
Walked on water (Matthew 14)	Denies Jesus 3 times (Luke 22)	Power and miracles through Jesus (Acts 3, and 9)
"Who do people say I am?" (Matthew 16)	"Do You love Me? Feed My sheep." (John 21)	

II. Transformation to a Reputation that Honors God

1. **BROKENESS** will be part of your transformation with Jesus. You can **BREAK YOURSELF** or wait till God breaks you.

"Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up in honor."
