1. Doing 'God's Will' requires **HUMILITY** in you and can provide **SALVATION** for you.

"So get rid of all the filth and evil in your lives, and humbly accept the word God has planted in your hearts, for it has the power to save your souls." James 1:21 (NLT)

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." 2 Timothy 2:15 (KJV)

2. Doing 'God's Will' requires OBEDIENCE/ACTION from you.

"But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves."

James 1:22(NLT)

3. Doing 'God's Will' requires <u>INTENTIONALITY</u> from you and can provide <u>BLESSINGS</u> for you.

"...accept the word God has planted in your hearts..." James 1:21b (NLT)

"For if you listen to the word and don't obey, it is like glancing at your face in a mirror." James 1:23 (NLT)

"You see yourself, walk away, and forget what you look like." James 1:24 (NLT)

"But **if** you **look carefully into** the perfect law that sets you free, and if you do what it says and don't forget what you heard, **then** God will **bless you** for doing it." James 1:25 (NLT)
