SENT: HERE, NEAR AND FAR

35 Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the Kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.

1. SEE what Jesus Sees.

"When Jesus saw the crowds . . . " (Verse 36a)

Who is Jesus calling you to see today?

2. FEEL what Jesus Feels.

"...He had **compassion** on them..." (Verse 36b)

Does your heart hurt for what God's heart hurts?

3. DO what Jesus Commands.

"Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. **Ask** the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to **send** out workers into His harvest field." (Verse 37,38)

[Jesus] "'Again.' He said, 'Peace be with you! As the Father has sent Me, **So I am sending you**.' Then He breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'" John 20:21-22 (NLT)

Am I doing what God sent me to do?

THE GREAT COMMISSION

"Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some doubted.
