



If Your Stuff Could Talk

(It Would Say “You’re the Manager, Not the Owner”)

Luke 16:1-14

Shrewd [shrood] adjective.

- Sharp powers of judgement, astute
- Sharp-witted, intelligent, clever, alert, far seeing

Managing God’s Stuff

1. What we think we own is just **ON LOAN**.

“There was a certain rich man who had a manager handling his affairs. One day a report came that the manager was **wasting his employer’s money.**”
Luke 16:1 (NLT)

“... when you obey me you should say, ‘We are unworthy servants who have **simply done our duty.**’”
Luke 17:10 (NLT)

“Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.”
Romans 12:1 (NIV)

2. We need to be **SHREWD** with money.

The dishonest manager did some things we can learn from...

- a) He **LOOKED AHEAD**. (Luke 16:3)

“The wise man **looks ahead.** The fool attempts to fool himself and won’t face facts.”
Proverbs 14:8 (LB)

- b) He **MADE A PLAN**. (Luke 16:4)

“We should make plans--**counting on God to direct us.**”
Proverbs 16:9 (LB)

- c) He put the plan into **ACTION**. (Luke 16: 5-6)

“Then the Lord said to Moses, ‘Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to **get moving!**’”
Exodus 14:15 (NLT)

3. Use money to **GET PEOPLE TO HEAVEN**.

“Here’s the lesson: **Use your worldly resources to benefit others and make friends.** Then, when your possessions are gone, they will welcome you to an eternal home.”
Luke 16:9 (NLT)

4. One day I’ll **GIVE AN ACCOUNT** of how I managed the resources God **LOANED TO ME**.

“... **Give an account of your management, because you cannot be manager any longer.**”
Luke 16:1 (NIV)
