Lessons from John 14

A deeply theological passage where Jesus offers comfort, guidance and promises for all who love and obey Him.

1) Jesus **COMFORTS** His Disciples (John 14:1-4)

[Jesus] "Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in Me." John 14:1 (NLT)

- Jesus acknowledges the disciples troubled hearts.
- He assures them that there is a place for them in His Father's house.
- Jesus promises to prepare a place for those who follow Him.

MY TAKEAWAY: _____

2) Jesus is **THE WAY** to the Father (John 14:5-7)

"Jesus told him, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life.'" John 14:6a (NLT)

- Thomas asks Jesus how they can know the way to where He is going.
- Jesus declares, *"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."*
- Jesus explains that knowing Him is knowing the Father.

MY TAKEAWAY: _____

3) Jesus **REVEALS** the power available through Him. (John 14:8-14)

[Jesus] "I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in Me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father." John 14:12 (NLT)

4)

- Philip asks Jesus to show them the Father.
- Jesus responds by saying that anyone who has seen Him has seen the Father.
- Jesus promises that those who believe in Him will do greater works because He is going to the Father.

MY TAKEAWAY: _____

4) Jesus **PROMISES** the Holy Spirit (John 14:15-21)

[Jesus] "If you love Me, obey My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you." John 14:15-16 (NLT)

- Jesus tells the disciples to keep His commandments as a sign of their love for Him.
- He promises to send the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, to be with them forever.
- He emphasizes the importance of love and obedience.

MY TAKEAWAY: _____

5) Jesus **GIVES** Peace (John 14:22-31)

[Jesus] "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart." John 14:27 (NLT)

- Jesus explains that those who love Him will keep His word, and the Father and He will make their home with them.
- He gives His peace to the disciples, a peace that's hard to understand.
- He tells them that He is going away, but He will come back to them.
