I. Why Am I Here?

“Why was I ever born? My entire life has been filled with trouble, sorrow, and shame.” Jeremiah 20:18 (NLT)

“You are worthy, O Lord our God, to receive glory and honor and power. For You created all things, and they exist because You created what You pleased.” Revelation 4:11 (NLT)

“Even before He made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes.” Ephesians 1:4 (NLT)

II. Does My Life Matter?

Three Levels of Life

1. Survival – just trying to pay the bills and keep going
2. Success – comfort, money, status
3. Significance – meaning and purpose in life

How Do I Live a Life of Significance?

1. Know the meaning of life.
2. Know how much you matter to God.
3. Live out God's 5 purposes for your life.
(Great Commandment & Great Commission)
