#### 1. <u>WASTE</u> Precious Time

"Be careful how you live. Don't live foolishly, instead live as wise people, making every minute count, because these are evil times." Ephesians 5:15-16 (NLT, CEV)

#### 2. <u>SEDUCED</u> into Worldly Temptations

"Don't copy the behavior of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think." Romans 12:2 (NLT) - Read also Colossians 3

#### 3. <u>LURED</u> into Unproductive Arguments

"Do not get involved in foolish discussions about spiritual pedigrees, or in quarrels and fights about obedience to Jewish laws. These things are useless and a waste of time. Titus 3:9-10 (NLT)

#### 4. **<u>TEMPTED</u>** to Compare & Compete for Approval

"Be careful! Don't do your acts of righteousness publicly to be admired by others. If you do, you will lose your reward from your Father in heaven." Matthew 6:1 (NLT)

#### 5. **DISTRACTED** from God's Purposes

"You are worried and distracted by many things, but really there is only one thing that is truly important, and Mary chose it." Luke 10:41-42 (NASB)

"Whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31 (CSB)
