- ⁹Jesus responded, 'Salvation has come to this home today, for this man has shown himself to be a true son of Abraham. ¹⁰For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.'"

3 Ways Jesus Responds When You "Go Out On a Limb" to Seek Him

1. Jesus will MEET you where you are. (v19:5a)

"When Jesus came by, He looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name..."

2. Jesus will INVITE you to let Him in. (v19:5b-6)

"...Zacchaeus!' He said. 'Quick, come down! I must be a guest in your home today.' Zacchaeus quickly climbed down and took Jesus to his house in great excitement and joy."

3. Jesus will TRANSFORM you to look like Him. (v19:8-9)

"Meanwhile, Zacchaeus stood before the Lord and said, 'I will give half my wealth to the poor, Lord, and if I have cheated people on their taxes, I will give them back four times as much!" Jesus responded, 'Salvation has come to this home today, for this man has shown himself to be a true son of Abraham.""
