

		Why did God rest?
		a) Because He was FINISHED .

"You have six days each week for your ordinary work, but the seventh day is a **Sabbath day of rest dedicated to the Lord your God...** For in six days the Lord made the heavens, the earth, the sea, and everything in them; but on the seventh day He rested. That is why the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and **set it apart as holy.**"
