

Isaiah 9:1-7 For Unto Us A Child Is Born Sunday, 12/12/21 Pastor Stuart Fraser

I. Introduction: Isaiah predicted that the Messiah would come to drive out the spiritual darkness in the land of Israel and bring about everlasting peace.

II. For Unto Us A Child Is Born (Isaiah 9:1-7).

- A. The Messiah's Illumination (vv. 1-2).
 - 1. Isaiah prophesied that the Messiah's influence would drive out the spiritual darkness that overshadowed Israel and bring enlightenment to God's people.

- B. The Messiah's Increase (vv. 2-5).
 - 1. Isaiah predicted that the people would rejoice because the coming of the Messiah would usher in a period of spiritual prosperity for Israel that was unparalleled.

- C. The Messiah's Incarnation (vv. 6-7).
 - 1. Isaiah's prophetic revelation came to a climactic end by announcing the birth of a son who would reign forever as Israel's rightful Davidic king.

III. Conclusion: God sent Isaiah to preach a message of hope to Israel that would be Good News for the entire world, for all who received God's Light would be saved.

Questions About: For Unto Us A Child Is Born

- 1. Who is the most significant person in human history? Why was Jesus so different from other people? Why has His impact been so tremendous? How does the Bible describe Him?
- 2. Why were the Jews so distressed in Isaiah's time? (Isa 9:1-2) What was the darkness that Isaiah mentioned? (v. 2) Do we live in a day of darkness? How is our nation like Israel?
- 3. What did Isaiah predict would happen in Galilee? (**Isa 9:1-2**) What was the great Light that they saw? (v. 2) How did Matthew indicate that Jesus fulfilled this prophecy? (**Matt 4:13-16**)
- 4. What did Isaiah say the Messiah would bring? (Isa 9:2-5) How would He increase their gladness? (v. 2) How does Jesus bring joy into our lives? (John 10:10)
- 5. Why did Isaiah say that they would be happy? (Isa 9:2-5) How would the Messiah break the yoke of their oppressors? (Isa 61:1) How did Jesus accomplish this for sinners? (John 8:36)
- 6. What is the significance that a son would be both born and given? (**Isa 9:6-7**) What did Isaiah say would be the name of this child? What is the significance of names?
- 7. What does it mean that the Messiah would be called a wonderful Counselor? (v. 6) Mighty God? (v. 6) Eternal Father? (v. 6) Prince of Peace? (v. 6) What do these titles mean to you?
- 8. How is God's promise to bring peace through the Messiah a needed message for His people today? Why should it matter that Jesus' dominion will be forever? (**Isa 9:6-7**)
