

Matt 28:1-20 Responses to the Resurrection Sunday, 4/4/21 – Pastor Stuart Fraser

I. Introduction: The resurrection is the most important event in human history, but the people who were eyewitnesses to it responded in vastly different ways.

II. Responses to the Resurrection (Matt 28:1-20).

- A. The Guards' Superstitious Fear (vv. 1-4).
 - 1. The first eyewitnesses to the resurrection were the Roman guards stationed in front of the tomb; they were terrified by the angel's presence at the grave.
- B. The Womens' Reverential Joy (vv. 5-10).
 - 1. The women that came to anoint the body of Jesus were shocked when they found the tomb empty, but they were filled with joy when they met Jesus moments later.
- C. The Jews' Hypocritical Hatred (vv. 11-15).
 - 1. The Jewish leaders responded to the resurrection by burying the truth, choosing instead to lie hypocritically to the Jewish people about Jesus' resurrection.
- D. The Disciples' Worshipful Reverence (vv. 16-20).
 - 1. Jesus appeared to His disciples, and they worshipped Him because they knew that He had resurrected from the grave and that He possessed all authority!

III. Conclusion: People today still respond to Jesus' resurrection with superstitious fear, reverential joy, hypocritical hatred, or worshipful reverence.

Study Questions: Reactions to the Resurrection

- 1. What were some ways that people reacted to Jesus' resurrection? The women? The Apostles? The Romans? The Jews? How would you have reacted? How does the world react today?
- 2. Who were the first people to experience the resurrection? (Matt 28:1-4) Who opened the tomb? (Matt 28:1-4) What did the angel look like? (v. 3) How did the soldiers respond?
- 3. What response did the women have to the resurrection? (Matt 26:5-8) What did the angel tell the women to do? (v. 6) What instructions did the angels give to the women? (v. 7)
- 4. Who did they run into on the way to tell the disciples? (Matt 26:8-9) What did they do when they saw Jesus? (v. 9) Why did they take hold of His feet? What does this reveal about them?
- 5. Who did the soldiers go and tell? (Matt 28:11-15) What did the Sanhedrin come up with as the official story? (vv. 12-15) What does this reveal about their character? (John 8:44-45)
- 6. How did the disciples respond to Jesus' resurrection? (Matt 28:16-20) Why were some still doubting? (v. 17) What assurance did Jesus give them? (v. 18) What command? (v. 20)
- 7. What does it mean that "all authority" has been given to Jesus? (Matt 28:18-20) How has Jesus defeated Satan? (Col 2:15; Heb 2:14; 1 John 3:8) How long will He be with us?
- 8. How will you respond to the resurrection of Jesus? Superstitious fear like the guards? Great joy like the women? Hypocritical hatred like the Jews? Worship like the disciples?

Prayer

- 1. Pray that God will reveal to you the significance of the resurrection today.
- 2. Ask God to show you how you can be saved from Satan, sin, and death.
