Heb 11:20-22

The Patriarchs: Transcendent Faith

- **I. Introduction:** The author of Hebrews commended the Patriarch's faith as the kind of saving faith God accepts, namely the conviction that God will fulfill all of His promises.
- **II.** The Patriarchs: Transcendent Faith (**Heb 11:20-22**).
 - A. A Reluctant Faith (v. 20; Gen 27:26-29).
 - 1. Isaac demonstrated faith in God by blessing Jacob and Esau, believing they would receive the promises made to his father, Abraham.

- B. A Fighting Faith (v. 21; Gen 49:1-28).
 - 1. Jacob's life was marked by striving with God and men, but at the end of his life, he demonstrated great faith by blessing Joseph's sons and worshipping God.

- C. An Expectant Faith (v. 22; Gen 50:22-26).
 - 1. Joseph's life was difficult, and even though God had greatly blessed him in Egypt, he made his descendants swear to bury his bones in Canaan.

III. Conclusion: The author encouraged his Jewish audience to live by faith like the Patriarchs, who all placed their hope in the future country God would give them.

- 6. How do we know God favored Joseph? (Gen 37:1-11) How did Joseph become a ruler in Egypt? (Gen 41-50) What were his sons named and what do their names mean? (Gen 41:50-57)
- 7. What led to Joseph's reconciliation with his brothers? (Gen 44:1-45:15) When did Joseph reunite with his father? (Gen 46:1-47:12) How did Jacob bless Joseph's sons? (Gen 48:1-22)
- 8. What instructions did Joseph give regarding his bones? (Heb 11:22; Gen 50:22-26) How did this indicate faith in God's promises? (Gen 50:24-25) How can we live a life of similar faith?
