Heb 11:5-6

Enoch – Walking by Faith

- **I. Introduction:** The author of Hebrews commended the faith of Enoch because he walked closely with God for over three hundred years and was taken home to heaven.
- **II.** Enoch Walking by Faith (**Heb 11:5-6**; **Gen 5:21-24**).
 - A. He Pleased God (**Heb 11:5**; **Gen 5:21-24**).
 - 1. Enoch walked with God, which is a phrase that indicates that he pleased God by the way that he conducted himself in life.
 - B. He Previewed Heaven (Heb 11:5; Gen 5:24).
 - 1. Enoch was eventually taken straight to heaven as a prototype of the hope of heaven that every believer will enjoy in the coming future.
 - C. He Pictured Faith (**Heb 11:6**).
 - 1. Enoch believed in God and that the Lord would reward him for his faithfulness, and he was taken to heaven as proof that God's promises are real.
 - D. He Preached Judgment (**Jude 14-15**).
 - 1. God testified that Enoch had faith in Him because he preached a message of judgment that would come upon the earth if those in his own time did not repent.
- **III. Conclusion:** The author encouraged his Jewish audience to live by faith, just as Enoch had pleased God by walking with Him faithfully for three hundred years.

Study Questions: Enoch – Walking by Faith

1.	How can a sinner please a holy God? What does it mean to walk with God by faith? Why does
	the author of Hebrews use Enoch as an example of faith? What happened to Enoch?

- 2. Who is Enoch, and what does his name mean? (Gen 5:21-24) When did Enoch start walking with God? (v. 21) How long did he walk with God after the birth of his son? (vv. 23-24)
- 3. What does it mean that Enoch walked with God? (**Heb 11:5**; **Gen 5:21-24**) Why does the author of Hebrews translate "walking" as pleasing God? Why does faith please God?
- 4. What does it mean that God took him up? (**Heb 11:5**; **Gen 5:24**) How does this pre-figure the church's rapture? (**1 Thess 4:13-18**) How does faith deliver sinners from death? (**Eph 2:8-9**)
- 5. What does the author say about faith? (**Heb 11:6**) Why is it impossible to please God apart from faith? What are some deeds people trust in to please God? Why don't they win His favor?
- 6. What must people believe about God? (**Heb 11:6**) What does it mean that someone must believe that "God is"? Why is it important to God that we believe that He is a rewarder? (**v. 6**)
- 7. What does the book of Jude tell us about Enoch? (**Jude 14-15**) What was society like in the days of Enoch? (**Gen 6:5-8**) What message did he preach? (**v. 15**)
- 8. What are the spiritual lessons that we are meant to learn from Enoch? (**Heb 11:5-6**) How does Enoch demonstrate how a person is saved? What is the message we are to proclaim?

Prayer

- 1. Ask God to help you walk closely with Him by faith, pleasing God in all you do.
- 2. Pray that God would give you the confidence to proclaim God's judgment against ungodliness.
