Joshua 9:1-27

Deceived By The Enemy

- **I. Introduction:** Joshua and the Israelites unwittingly made a covenant with the Gibeonites because they deceived them into believing that they were from a distant land.
- **II.** Deceived By The Enemy (**Josh 9:1-27**).
 - A. Spiritual Gullibility (vv. 1-6).
 - 1. The Gibeonites formulated a plan to deceive Israel into believing that they were foreigners in the land of Canaan so that Israel would make a covenant with them.
 - B. Spiritual Carelessness (vv. 7-15).
 - 1. The Gibeonites deceived Israel into believing that they were foreigners because they believed in what they had seen and didn't seek God's counsel.
 - C. Spiritual Illumination (vv. 16-21).
 - 1. The Israelites discovered that the Gibeonites had deceived them, but they were forbidden from killing them because they had sworn an oath to God.
 - D. Spiritual Shrewdness (vv. 22-27).
 - 1. Joshua confronted the Gibeonite deception and cursed them, making them slaves in the Tabernacle so that their idolatry wouldn't spread throughout Israel.
- **III. Conclusion:** Israel realized they needed to be vigilant in detecting the enemies lies so that they would not be exploited by those who pretended to be their allies.

5.	How did Israel find out Gibeon lied to them? (Josh 9:16-21) What should Christians do when they give their word? (Matt 5:37) How is God's reputation at stake?
6.	Why was Israel concerned about violating this treaty? (Josh 9:18-21) Why didn't the enemy's lies invalidate the pact? (v. 19) Do you keep your word even when it's difficult?
7.	How did Joshua confront the Gibeonite's lies? (Josh 9:22-27) Why did they lie to Joshua and the leaders? (v. 24) How did they appeal to the compassion of the Israelites? (v. 24)
8.	What was the Gibeonite's punishment for their deception? (Josh 9:26-27) How did it expose them to the worship of God? What are we meant to learn from this story?
