

<u>Genesis 3:8-15</u> The Judgment of God's Image-Bearers Sunday, 10/10/21 – Pastor Stuart Fraser

- I. Introduction: Adam and Eve had committed open rebellion against God, but the Lord pursued them and offered them redemption even after they committed treason.
- II. The Judgment of God's Image-Bearers (Gen 3:8-15).
 - A. The Confrontation of Adam (vv. 8-10).
 - 1. God knew about mankind's rebellion, so He went to find Adam to confront him and give him the opportunity to repent of his sin.
 - B. The Interrogation by God (vv. 11-13).
 - 1. God questioned Adam and Eve about their disobedience, but they now feared Him, so they attempted to hide and blame their rebellion on others.
 - C. The Condemnation of Satan (v. 14).
 - 1. God condemned Satan for leading His image-bearers in rebellion against Him and cursed the snake so that he would forever be the symbol of humiliation.
 - D. The Prediction of Doom (v. 15).
 - 1. God put enmity between Satan and humanity, sentencing the Devil to destruction by the offspring of the woman who would completely defeat him.
- III. Conclusion: God cursed the serpent, who ruined His paradise, and prophesied that the offspring of the woman would one day deliver a fatal blow to him.

Study Questions: The Judgment of God's Image-Bearers

- 1. How were Adam and Eve less like God after they sinned? (**Gen 3:6-7**) How were they more like Satan? How did mankind's sin affect the physical universe? (**Rom 8:20-23**)
- 2. What happened to Adam and Eve when they ate the fruit? (Gen 3:8-10) What does it mean that their eyes were opened? (v. 7) Why did they cover themselves with fig leaves? (v. 8)
- 3. Why did Adam and Eve hide from God? (**Gen 3:8-10**) Why did God ask where they were? (**v. 9**) How was this a display of His grace? Why did they fear God after sinning? (**v. 10**)
- 4. What questions did God ask Adam and Eve? (Gen 3:11-13) What did Adam's hiding reveal about him? (v. 10) Why was he afraid? (v. 10) Where did he learn the word naked? (v. 11)
- 5. Who did Adam blame for his sin? (**Gen 3:11-13**) How did he imply that God was somewhat responsible for his sin? (**v. 12**) Why do sinners avoid taking responsibility for sin?
- 6. Who did Eve blame for her sin? (v. 13) Who do you blame for your sin? What is false repentance from sin? (2 Cor 7:8-10) What is true repentance? (2 Cor 7:10; 1 John 1:9)
- 7. What curse did God pronounce on the serpent? (**Gen 3:14**) Why did God pronounce a curse on the snake? What did it mean that the serpent would eat dust? (**Isa 65:25**; **Mic 7:17**)
- 8. What promise was embedded in the curse of Satan? (**Gen 3:15**) Who is the *seed* of the woman? Who was the One that would crush Satan's head? (**Col 2:15**; **Heb 2:14**; **1 John 3:8**)

Praver

- 1. Ask God to reveal to you if you have been trying to evade His judgment for sin.
- 2. Pray that God might forgive you of any sins that you have in your life as His image-bearer.
