

Joshua 24:1-33

We Will Serve The Lord

- **I. Introduction:** Joshua delivered a farewell challenge to the tribes of Israel to follow the Lord after his death, putting away all idols and committing to serving Him alone.
- II. We Will Serve The Lord (Josh 24:1-33).
 - A. Israel's Past Blessings (vv. 1-13).
 - 1. Joshua recalled for Israel all that God had done from the time of Abraham into their present time to bring them into Canaan and give them the land.
 - B. Israel's Present Summons (vv. 14-18).
 - 1. Joshua called Israel to rededicate themselves to God and forsake the gods of this world to serve Him with their whole hearts.
 - C. Israel's Personal Commitment (vv. 19-28).
 - 1. Joshua explained that Israel would not be able to obey God the way He commaded them to because they didn't have the ability to love Him.
 - D. Israel's Promised Inheritance (vv. 29-33).
 - 1. Israel continued to follow God all the days of Joshua, and they buried him in the territory that God promised him, along with Joseph and Eleazar.
- **III. Conclusion:** Joshua lived out all the days of his life in victory and peace, and God fulfilled every promise He had made to Joshua and His people.

- 7. Why did Joshua tell them to put away their idols? (**Josh 24:23-24**) How did God give Jacob the same instruction in Shechem? (**Gen 35:4**) Are there any idols in your life?
- 8. What three funerals are mentioned at the end of Joshua? (**Josh 24:29-33**) How did these funerals prove God's faithfulness? (**Josh 21:43-45; 23:14**) Can God's promises be trusted?
