Heb 11:23-29

Moses: Fearless Faith

- **I. Introduction:** The author of Hebrews commended the faith of Moses as an example of the fearless kind of faith that God desires to see in all of His people.
- II. Moses: Fearless Faith (Heb 11:23-29).
 - A. Faith's Rebellion (v. 23).
 - 1. The parents of Moses demonstrated great courage by protecting the life of Moses, not fearing the consequences of disobeying the king's command.
 - B. Faith's Rejection (vv. 24-26).
 - 1. Moses rejected Egypt's sinful pleasures so that he could live the life God wanted him to pursue rather than a life of carnal pursuits.
 - C. Faith's Submission (v. 27).
 - 1. Moses led the nation of Israel out of Egypt by faith, trusting in the Lord's plan to bring them into the Promised Land as He predicted He would.
 - D. Faith's Conviction (v. 28).
 - 1. Moses instructed God's people to sprinkle lamb's blood on the doorposts of their homes so that Israel's firstborn males would not be killed.
 - E. Faith's Salvation (v. 29).
 - 1. Moses led the Jews through the Red Sea, knowing that God would sovereignly protect them from the Egyptian army.
- **III. Conclusion:** The author urged his Jewish audience to live by faith like Moses, who demonstrated his trust in God by leading Israel out of Egypt.

Study Questions: Moses – Fearless Faith

- 1. What kind of faith pleases God? Why is Moses a key figure in the author's list of those who lived by faith? How did Moses demonstrate the doctrine of salvation by faith?
- 2. How did Moses' parents courageously preserve his life? (**Heb 11:23; Ex 2:1-10**) Why did his parents defy the command of Pharoah? (**v. 23**) When is it appropriate to defy a human ruler?
- 3. In what ways did Moses reject Egypt's sinful temptations? (**Heb 11:24-26**) Why did Moses refuse to be called the son of Pharoah's daughter? (**v. 24**) How could it have brought him fame?
- 4. How did Moses choose suffering over sin? (**Heb 11:25-26**) Why is sin such a temptation to people? (v. 25) What did Moses consider greater than the riches of Egypt? (v. 26)
- 5. Why did the author commend Moses for leaving Egypt? (**Heb 11:27**) How was Moses able to lead Israel out of Egypt? (**Ex 3-12**) Why did this require Moses to believe in the unseen God?
- 6. How was observing the Passover an act of faith? (**Heb 11:28**) What were the Jews required to do to avoid God's judgment? (**Ex 12:1-13**) How did this foreshadow Jesus' redemption?
- 7. What was one of the most climactic acts of faith in Moses' life? (**Heb 11:29**) What did Moses proclaim about God? (**Ex 14:13-14**) What happened to Pharoah's army? (**Ex 14:26-31**)
- 8. How can you trust in God's sovereignty like Moses' parents? (**Heb 11:23**) What can you learn about rejecting sin's pleasures from Moses? Are you trusting in God's deliverance?

- 1. Ask God to help you to live a life of faith like Moses, rejecting the world's sinful pleasures.
- 2. Pray that God would cause you to trust in His provision of salvation through Jesus Christ.
