

## Joshua 10:1-27

#### God Fights For Israel

- **Introduction:** As a result of Israel fulfilling their covenant agreement with Gibeon, God fought for Israel.
- II. God Fights For Israel (Josh 10:1-27).
  - A. God Collects Israel's Enemies (vv. 1-5).
    - 1. The Five kings of the South attacked Gibeon when they discovered that they had allied themselves with Israel, but God used their foolishness to destroy them.
  - B. God Crushes Israel's Enemies (vv. 6-14).
    - 1. Israel marched all night to protect the Gibeonites, so God confounded the enemy and performed mighty miracles against the enemy.

- C. God Cursed Israel's Enemies (vv. 15-27).
  - 1. The Israelites killed the kings of the South and destroyed their armies, proving that Israel's God had fought against His enemies and defeated their gods.

**III. Conclusion:** God fought for Israel against the five kings of the South, turning the foolish decision of His people into one of their most significant victories.

# 8. Why did they hang the kings? (**Josh 10:26-27**) How was Jesus hung on a tree to redeem His enemies? (**Gal 3:13**) Are you on God's side? When Christ returns, will He fight for or against you?
