Heb 11:4; Gen 4:1-16

Abel – Sacrificial Faith

- **I. Introduction:** The author of Hebrews commended the faith of Abel as an example to be followed because he brought a better sacrifice to God than his brother.
- II. Abel Sacrificial Faith (Heb 11:4; Gen 4:1-16).
 - A. Two Sons Contrasted (Gen 4:1-5a).
 - 1. Adam and Eve had two children after the Fall who were taught to worship God and offer Him sacrifices, but only Abel did what God wanted him to do.
 - B. Two Heart Attitudes (Gen 4:5b-7).
 - 1. God went to Cain and encouraged him to make the proper sacrifice, warning him of the consequences of worshipping Him in his own self-styled way.
 - C. Two Paths Offered (Gen 4:8-10).
 - 1. Cain chose to ignore God's admonition and instead killed his brother in cold blood because Abel's sacrifice was better than his own.
 - D. Two Destinies Diverge (Gen 4:11-16).
 - 1. Cain was cursed by God and exiled as a son of the devil, while Abel was honored in the hall of faith as a righteous man, a true son of God.
- **III. Conclusion:** The author encouraged his Jewish audience to live by faith, just as Abel had obtained a righteous standing with God through his obedient sacrifice.

Study Questions: Abel – Sacrificial Faith

- 1. What does the right kind of faith look like? How do sinners approach a holy God? Why does the author start with Abel? Why is he a brilliant choice to begin the hall of faith?
- 2. What does the author of Hebrews praise Abel for in the story? (**Heb 11:4**) How did Abel's sacrifice prove that he was righteous? How does Abel still speak, though he is dead? (v. 4)
- 3. How did Moses contrast Cain and Abel in Genesis? (Gen 4:1-5) What do their names mean? (v. 1) Why did Moses specify their occupations? (v. 2) How does this play into the story?
- 4. Why was Abel's sacrifice accepted and Cain's rejected? (Gen 4:1-5) How do we know God desired a blood sacrifice? (Gen 3:21; Heb 9:22) What does this tell us about worship?
- 5. Why did Cain respond to God in anger? (Gen 4:5b-7) What did God encourage Cain to do? (v. 7) What warning did God give to Cain regarding sin? (v. 7) Why did God warn him?
- 6. How did Cain respond to God's rebuke? (Gen 4:8-10) Why did Cain kill Abel? (v. 8; 1 John 3:12) What did it reveal about Cain? (John 8:44; Jude 11) How did God confront him?
- 7. What curse did God place on Cain because he murdered his brother? (Gen 4:11-16) How did God deal graciously with Cain? (v. 15) What eventually happened to Cain? (v. 16)
- 8. What are Christians supposed to learn from this story? (**Heb 11:4**) How is Abel an example of sacrificial faith? (**1 John 3:12**) How is Cain an example of selfish apostasy? (**Jude 11**)

Prayer

- 1. Ask God to help you worship Him sincerely, giving sacrificially to Him in faith.
- 2. Pray that God would give you the confidence to believe in His promises in simple belief.
