MISSIONS

Greetings in the Precious Name of Our Lord Jesus Christ!

We are filled with gratitude as we share the latest updates from our ministry here in the Philippines. Your faithful prayers and support continue to make a lasting impact, and we are excited to give you a glimpse of what God is doing through our mission churches and the new campsite project.

Campsite Development: A Vision Becoming Reality

By God's grace, we have begun developing a beautiful campsite that will serve as a spiritual haven for retreats, youth camps, leadership training, and discipleship programs. Nestled in the heart of God's creation, this site is already drawing hearts closer to Him.

From May 26—28, 2025, we held our third annual Junior Camp, which was a resounding success. One hundred children from our church and surrounding communities participated. With the theme "Choosing to Serve the King," the camp focused on nurturing faith, character, and a deep love for God in young hearts.

As our camp ministry continues to grow, we are seeing a greater need for proper accommodations—especially for the children and youth who attend our annual camps. Currently, our shelters are limited and temporary, making it difficult to host campers comfortably and safely.

We are praying and believing God for the provision to build new cabins—simple, durable structures that can house 38 campers each. These cabins will provide a safe, comfortable, and spiritually enriching environment for every child and young person who comes to seek God during camp.

The land has already been cleared, and we've constructed a dirt road leading to the site by the river. We are also praying for amphitheater seating for rallies, restroom facilities, and the resources to begin construction on dorm-style cabins and a multi-purpose hall. Our vision is to create a space that will equip and empower future leaders and serve as a refuge for spiritual rest and renewal.

Please continue to pray for the provision of materials and for the safety of our workers as we move forward in faith.

Mission Churches: Growing in Faith and Number

Our mission churches continue to grow both spiritually and numerically. From the farmlands to the fishing towns and mountain villages, God is touching lives through worship services, Bible studies, and outreach programs.



In one of our mountain churches—San Martin Cawag Baptist Mission—two young souls recently made a public declaration of faith through baptism. It was a joy and blessing to witness Pastor Zarel Fausto baptize the fruits of his faithful ministry.



Many of our mission pastors travel long distances to reach their congregations. Please pray for strength, protection, and provision for these dedicated servants, and that the seeds they plant will grow into strong, multiplying communities of faith.
