

## NOVEMBER 2ND

#### LOOKING LIKE JESUS

About 70 years ago a husband and wife travelled as missionaries to India. They had two sons, 8 and 12 years old. Their parents left them both to go to India and take up their tour of duty there. Their intention was that once they got settled they would send for the boys.

But shortly after they left America, World War II broke out. They couldn't get to the boys, and they couldn't get the boys to them. So the separation between the missionaries and their sons went on for eight years.

When the war was over, the parents returned to America. Their oldest son was 20 years old and in college. He recalled how excited he was when he got the word that his parents would soon arrive in their hometown by train. The son got to the train depot early, even before the sun came up. When the train finally pulled in, the mother and father were the only ones who got off the train. The son wrote these words:

"I could barely see them in the haze, and they could hardly see me. We embraced in the semi-darkness. Then my mother took my hand and led me into the light of the waiting room. There were tears running down her cheeks as she looked at me. She kept looking at my face, staring hard. Then she turned to my dad and called him by name, 'Arnett,' she cried, 'he's gone and looked just like you! He looks just like you!

That is what God wants of us! That we grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ that we look just like Him.

"But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass (mirror) the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord." -2 Corinthians 3:18
