

CONTEXT

- The circumstances that form the setting for an event, statement, or idea, and in terms of which it can be fully understood and assessed:
- 2. The parts of something written or spoken that immediately precede and follow a word or passage and clarify its meaning:

We are prone to say that in the Bible "context is everything", meaning that if a verse is taken "out of context" it can be used to teach error, or heresy even. Let's be true to the Word of God this year. To help us understand this consider the word—RUN

When you run a fever those three letters have a very different meaning than when you run a bath or when the bath runs over and drenches your cotton bath runner, causing you to have to run to the store for a new one. There you run up a charge of \$85 because you also bought some thread to fix the run in your stockings and some tissue for your runny nose and gallon of milk because you have run out at home, and all this makes anxiety run through your soul because you have already run over your budget for the week. On the way home you run over a nail and now your car won't operate unless you run to the Tire Shop for it to be repaired, or you will be running late for work tomorrow, all the while your children are running amok. All of this is running through your mind. And you think— "Things would be so different if I ran the world, or maybe I will just run for political office."

Guess I'd better stop as I have let this run on long enough.

I have heard that English is a very hard language to learn.

God wants us to study and learn His Word so we can apply it to our hearts and lives and live by it! And to "run with patience the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus the Author and Finisher of our faith." - Hebrews 12.
