Sunday Morning Service: 11:00am

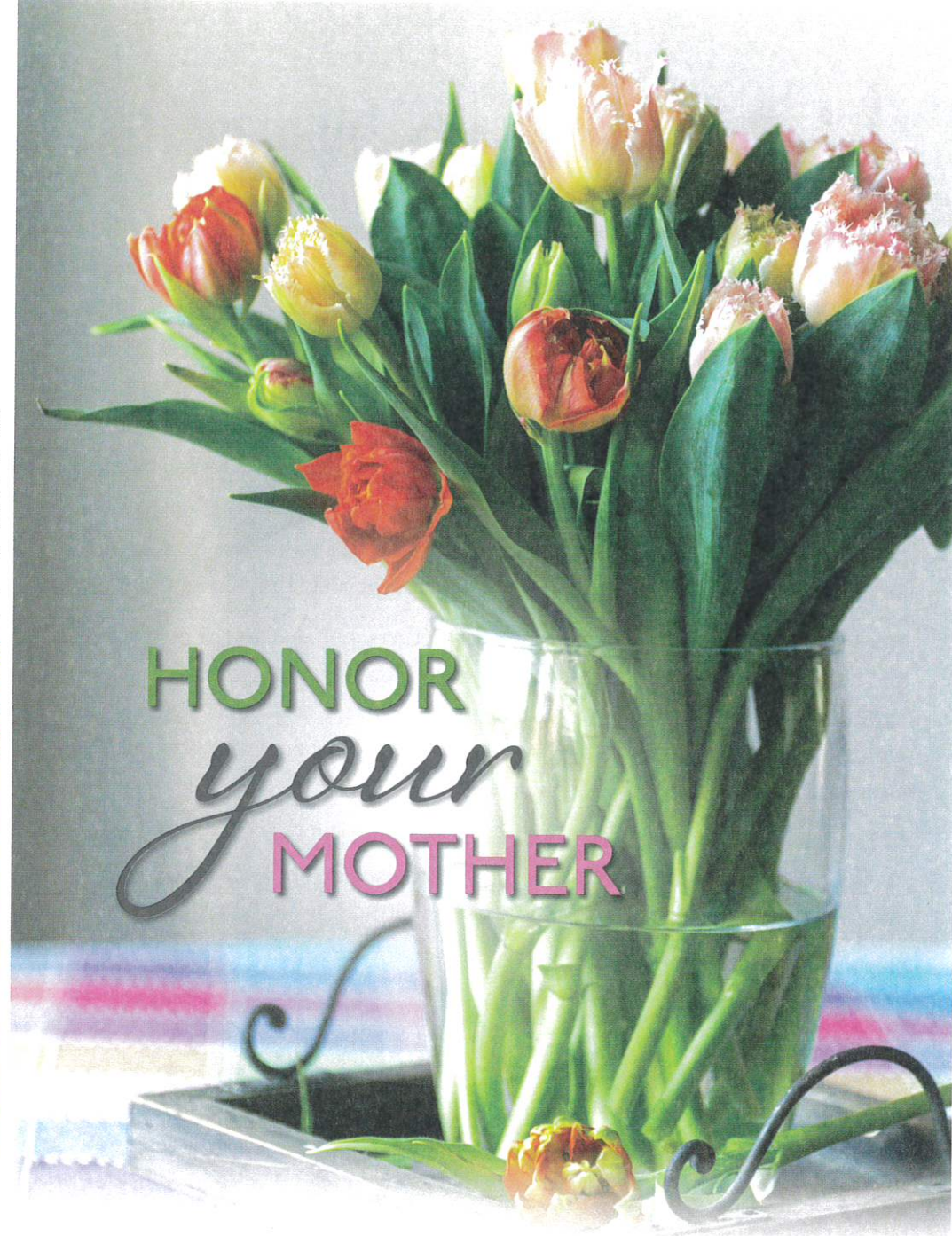

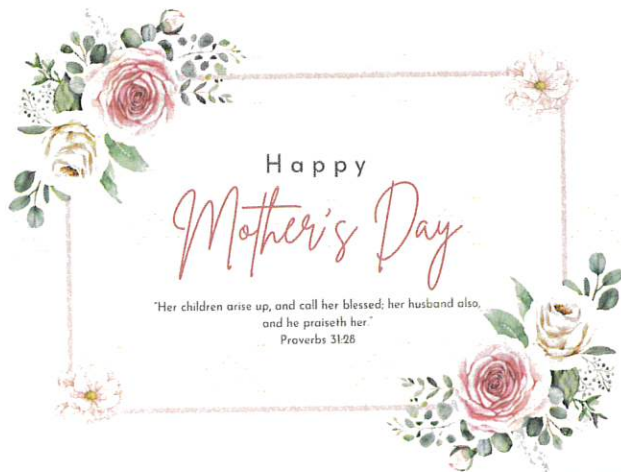
Mother's Influence
