



## Spain Trip Prayer Card

July 3-12, 2025

**DAY 1: Thursday, July 3rd** • Please pray for light traffic and safe travel as our team drives to D.C. and then a late-night flight to Valencia, Spain. Pray for safety for Rick and Sue Starr as they drop the team off and drive back to Williamsburg. Pray for smooth connections for the team in Paris and no late or delayed flights along the way. Pray for rest on the flights. *The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working. - James 5:16b*

**DAY 2: Friday, July 4th** • Continue to pray for health and safety as our team proceeds to Valencia, arriving in the afternoon, Spain time. Please also pray that all our luggage makes it safely without any issues. Pray that all goes smoothly with our rental cars. Ask for rest for the team as we prepare to start ministry. Please bathe Fina and Fernando in prayer this week. Pray for Christ's loving arms to be felt as our team is here this week. There are so few believers here that it can get very lonely. Pray for renewed strength, rest and passion for Fina and Fernando. *Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established - Proverbs 16:3*

**DAY 3: Saturday, July 5th** • Pray for the team as we prepare for a week of kid's camp ministry. Pray that we will be able to find all the supplies that we need for the crafts. Lift up the team as they will be acclimating to a new culture, dealing with heat, new foods and smells, not being able to speak the language, a completely different eating schedule, and probably tiredness from the trip as well as culture shock. Pray that we will set our own rights/wants aside and be unified in loving others, encouraging one another, and showing the love of Jesus in all we do. Pray for the Lord to prepare our hearts for what's ahead. *Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age. - Matthew 28:19-20*

**DAY 4: Sunday, July 6th** • Join us in prayer as we worship together at the Church in Picassent. Pray for Andri as she leads in worship (in Spanish!) Ask the Lord to speak powerfully and clearly through Wes as he preaches, Rob, Susan, and Carolina as they share their testimonies, and for Weston as he translates. Pray that the Lord would give Wes the words that he needs so that the message would be clear. Pray for soft, receptive hearts of the people. Lift up lunch/fellowship after church, that we would encourage the believers there. *Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! - Psalm 96:3*

**DAY 5: Monday, July 7th** • Pray for the team as we begin Day 1 of the kids' camp this morning. Ask the Lord to bring kids!! Pray for openness in the community, as evangelicals are often distrusted and seen as a cult. Lift up the team as we lead games, crafts, and a Bible story. Ask for strength and endurance for us as we minister in the heat. Pray that the Lord would give Jonathan the words he needs to clearly and powerfully share the Gospel

and his testimony with the kids. Lift up the team as we head to different small groups to share our testimonies and encourage believers. Ask the Lord to give us words to say.

*Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord! - Psalm 27:14*

**DAY 6: Tuesday, July 8th** • Please pray for safety for the kids and for the team as we continue with Day 2 of our camp. Ask for continued unity among the team as we minister alongside each other. Pray that we will be intentional in reaching out to the kids that the Lord puts on our hearts, and that we will look for opportunities to show Christ's love. Pray for Carolina as she shares her testimony/Gospel and Weston as he translates. Please lift up Wes, Michelle, Weston, and Jonathan as they continue to translate, and please ask the Lord to keep each one of us strong and healthy. Ask the Lord to use our testimonies in a powerful way as share among their different small groups. Pray that new truths would take root in the hearts of the believers there. *Fear not, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. - Isaiah 41:10*

**DAY 7: Wednesday, July 9th** • As we start Day 3 of ministry, please pray for the opportunity to connect with the parents who are dropping kids off. Pray for new connections in the community, and that the believers in the church would be encouraged and energized by our team. Lift up Lucas as he shares his testimony/Gospel with the kids and for Weston as he translates! Pray that all goes smoothly with all the different details of the camp. Please pray that today's activities will provide many opportunities to share the message of Christ. Ask that the Holy Spirit would lead speak through us as we visit small groups and share our testimonies. Pray for courage and boldness, as this isn't always easy! *Press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. - Philippians 3:14*

**DAY 8: Thursday, July 10th** • Please pray for hungry and open hearts for the children who will participate in our last day of camp! Pray for the intentionality of the team, that we would be sensitive to the voice of the Lord and be bold for Christ. Lift up Andri as she leads a kid's song in Spanish, and Shelby as she shares her testimony/Gospel. Pray for the team as we prayer walk, ask the Lord to open our eyes to the spiritual warfare going on around us, so that we can be intentional to do battle in prayer. Pray for obedience and boldness. *Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." - Matthew 9:37-38*

**DAY 9: Friday, July 11th** • The team will spend the day sightseeing and learning more about the culture of Spain. Fina and Fernando will join us, so pray specifically for their encouragement as they will stay behind to cultivate the seeds we have sown while we were here. Pray for endurance and rest for them. Pray for other leaders to be raised up, so that Fina and Fernando would have help as they continue to minister. Pray for the team as we debrief tonight and bring home to put into practice the things the Lord has shown us on this trip. *At the works of your hands I sing for joy. - Psalm 92:4b*

**DAY 10: Saturday, July 12th** • Pray for safety and health for the team as we go in different directions from here. Pray for Rob, Susan, Shelby and Lucas as they take an early morning flight from Valencia, layover in Paris, land in D.C. in the evening and then drive back to Williamsburg. Pray for Jonathan and Carolina as they stay in Spain to continue to help Fina and Fernando and the church for another month. Give thanks for the opportunity to serve the Lord in Spain as you prayer warriors have made a HUGE impact on the trip and have had an eternal impact on the people of Spain as well! *I am the Lord; I have called you in righteousness; I will take you by the hand and keep you. -Is. 42:6a*
