BIG IDEA:

Gratitude shifts our focus from what we lack to what we have, helping us resist greed and embrace contentment in God's provision.



1 THESSALONIANS 5:16–18 (CSB)

Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.



Consumerism requires us to be unsatisfied and spend, as it is a worldview.

Gratitude is a habit cultivated in partnership with joy and prayer.

"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks..." (vv. 16–18a)



The attitude of gratitude is cultivated through two daily decisions:

(1) choosing joy and

(2) staying connected to God

Live with a steady awareness that God is near, that grace is available, that help is here.

Joy turns your eyes toward who God is.

Prayer keeps our hearts connected to the God who is.



We can't live a life of thankfulness if we aren't joyful, and we can't stay joyful if we aren't prayerful.



GRATITUDE BELONGS IN EVERY SEASON

"...in all circumstances..." (v.18b)



Gratitude is how faith breathes when life feels suffocating.



I can't change my circumstances, but I can always choose my response.



GRATITUDE IS NOT OPTIONAL

"...for this is the will of God..." (v.18c)



Gratitude centers us in the truth that God is sovereign, and I am secure.



Gratitude Is Rooted in a Relationship with Jesus "...in Christ Jesus." (v.18d)



Gratitude is about being in Christ, not about being positive.



You are in Christ, and because of that, you live from abundance, not scarcity. You're you're already loved, already chosen, already supplied.
