1 JOHN 4:13 (CSB)

This is how we know that we remain in him and he in us:

He has given us of his Spirit.



BIG IDEA:

The Holy Spirit gives us confidence and peace, assuring us of our relationship with God and empowering us to live boldly in His love.



We don't love to prove we're saved.

We love because we're sealed.

God shows us how to love



1JOHN 4:9-10 (CSB)

God's love was revealed among us in this way: God sent his one and only Son into the world so that we might live through him. Love consists in this: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the atoning sacrifice, for our sins.



1JOHN 4:14 (CSB)

And we have seen and we testify that the Father has sent his Son as the world's Savior.



Jesus steps into our condition, and does not wait for us to get it together.



1JOHN 4:19 (CSB)

We love because he first loved us.



1JOHN 4:15 (CSB)

Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God—God remains in him and he in God.



1JOHN 4:7-8 (CSB)

Dear friends, let us love one another, because love is from God, and everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. The one who does not love does not know God, because God is love



- God loves intentionally WITH PURPOSE
- God loves sacrificially AT GREAT COST
- God loves unconditionally WITHOUT PRETENSE
- God loves selflessly WITH OTHERS AT THE CENTER

1JOHN 4:15-16 (CSB)

Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God—God remains in him and he in God. 16 And we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us.



1JOHN 4:18 (CSB)

There is no fear in love; instead, perfect love drives out fear, because fear involves punishment. So the one who fears is not complete in love.

1JOHN 4:20 (CSB)
