**CHOOSING
CALLING OVER
COMFORT**

Hebrews 11:23–28





BIG IDEA

Faith says no to comfort so it can say yes to calling.



“Calling” is living in conformity to His character and His commands, wherever you are, in whatever you do, right now, with what you have.

HEBREWS 11:23-28 (CSB)

By faith Moses, after he was born, was hidden by his parents for three months, because they saw that the child was beautiful, and they didn't fear the king's edict.

HEBREWS 11:23-28 (CSB)

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter ²⁵ and chose to suffer with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasure of sin.

HEBREWS 11:23-28 (CSB)

For he considered reproach for the sake of Christ to be greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, since he was looking ahead to the reward.

HEBREWS 11:23-28 (CSB)

By faith he left Egypt behind, not being afraid of the king's anger, for Moses persevered as one who sees him who is invisible. By faith he instituted the Passover and the sprinkling of the blood,

HEBREWS 11:23-28 (CSB)

so that the destroyer of the firstborn might not touch the Israelites.

**Choosing calling means obedience to God is greater
than obedience to people (v. 23).**

Choosing calling means identity in Christ is greater than every other identity (v. 24).

HEBREWS 11:24 (CSB)

By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter

**Choosing calling means being willing to pay the cost
(v. 25).**

HEBREWS 11:25 (CSB)

and chose to suffer with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasure of sin.

**Choosing calling means valuing a different currency
(v. 26–27).**

HEBREWS 11:26-27 (CSB)

For he considered reproach for the sake of Christ to be greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, since he was looking ahead to the reward. By faith he left Egypt behind, not being afraid of the king's anger,

HEBREWS 11:26-27 (CSB)

**for Moses persevered as one who sees him who is
invisible.**

**Choosing calling means acting before the evidence
arrives (v. 28).**

HEBREWS 11:28 (CSB)

By faith he instituted the Passover and the sprinkling of the blood, so that the destroyer of the firstborn might not touch the Israelites.
