But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”*

**(John 20:22)** *“Receive the Holy Spirit.”*

**(Luke 4:18-19)** *“The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.”*

*‘baptize’ (def) - immersed, saturated, submerged*

#### BIG IDEA OF SERIES

You can have a \_\_\_\_\_ relationship with the Holy Spirit than you have right now.

**(Acts 19:1-7)** *“And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples he said to them, “**Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?**” So they said to him, “We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.” And he said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?” So they said, “Into John’s baptism.” Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. Now the men were about twelve in all.”*

#### The Three Dimensions of Relationship With The Holy Spirit

1. THE FIRST DIMENSION: The Holy Spirit is \_\_\_\_\_  
everyone, including unbelievers.

**(John 16:7-11 NKJV)** *“Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: of sin, because they do not believe in Me; of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.”*

The Holy Spirit is \_\_\_\_\_ the unbeliever but not \_\_\_\_\_ the unbeliever.

**(John 14:16-17 NKJV)** “And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever; the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.”

2. THE SECOND DIMENSION: The Holy Spirit is \_\_\_\_\_  
all people who have put their faith in Jesus Christ for salvation.

**(Galatians 4:6)** “Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit into our hearts.”

**(Roman 8:9)** “You, however, are controlled by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you, and if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.”

**(1 John 3:24)** “Those who obey God’s commands live in Him and He in them. And this is how we know He lives in us. We know it by the Spirit He gave us.”

**(2 Tim. 1:14)** “Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you, guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.”

**(1 Cor. 12:13)** “We were all baptized by one Spirit into one body.”

**(1 Cor. 6:19)** “You are the temple of the Holy Spirit.”

What is the Holy Spirit’s role in our salvation?

**(Titus 3:5 NKJV)** “not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of **regeneration** and renewing of the Holy Spirit.”

“regenerate”

(def) “A spiritual renovation, the process of being made spiritually alive”

**(John 3:5)** “Unless a man is born of the Spirit he cannot enter the kingdom of heaven.”

**(Eph. 2:1)** “As for you, you were dead in your trespasses and sins”

**(Ezekiel 37:14)** “I will put my Spirit in you and you shall live.”

**(2 Cor. 3:6)** “The Spirit gives life”

**(Col. 2:13)** “You were dead in your sins . . . God made you alive in Christ.”

The Holy Spirit provides \_\_\_\_\_

**(Rom. 8:16)** “The Spirit Himself testifies with our Spirit that we are the children of God.”

**(1 John 4:13)** “We know that we live in Him and He in us, because He has given us His Spirit.”

**(Eph. 1:13-14)** “The promised Holy Spirit . . . Is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance.”

**(1 John 5:6)** “It is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is truth.”

**(2 Cor. 1:21-22)** “He anointed us, set His seal of ownership in us, and put His spirit in our hearts, guaranteeing what is to come.”

**(Eph. 4:30)** “And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.”

The Holy Spirit \_\_\_\_\_ Us

**(Heb. 12:14)** “Without holiness no man shall see the Lord.”

**(1 Peter 1:1-2)** To God’s elect . . . Who have been chosen . . . Through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ.”

**(2 Thes. 2:13)** “From the beginning God chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.”

**(Rom. 1:4)** “The Spirit of holiness”

**(1 Cor. 6:11)** “You were washed, you were sanctified . . . in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.”
