

Sunday School


Next one is April 21st.


He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty.

Hebrews 10:26-31; We Can't Go On Like That!



(A false view that is satanically influenced. Eph. 2:2-3)






A faulty foundation that is sure to fail

ECHO CHAMBER

An echo chamber is what happens when insiders come to distrust everybody on the outside.

And that means that an insider's trust for other insiders can grow unchecked.

EPISTEMIC BUBBLE

An epistemic bubble is what happens when insiders **aren't exposed** to people from the opposite side.

They hear arguments and evidence only from their side of the political spectrum and are never exposed to the other side's views.

Romans 9:6 But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel, ⁷ and not all are children of Abraham because they are his offspring, but "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named."

Covenant keepers outwardly are **not** always Covenant recipient inwardly.

²⁸ Anyone who has **set aside** the law of Moses **dies without mercy** on the <u>evidence</u> of two or three witnesses.

Numbers 15:27 "If one person sins unintentionally, he shall offer a female goat a year old for a sin offering. ²⁸ And the priest shall make atonement before the Lord for the person who makes a mistake, when he sins unintentionally, to make atonement for him, and he shall be forgiven. 29 You shall have one law for him who does anything unintentionally, for him who is native among the people of Israel and for the stranger who sojourns among them. ³⁰ But the person who does anything with a high hand, whether he is native or a sojourner, reviles the Lord, and that person shall be cut off from among his people. ³¹ Because he has despised the word of the Lord and has broken his commandment, that person shall be utterly cut off; his iniquity shall be on him."

How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has **trampled** underfoot the Son of God, and has **profaned** the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has **outraged** the **Spirit** of grace?
